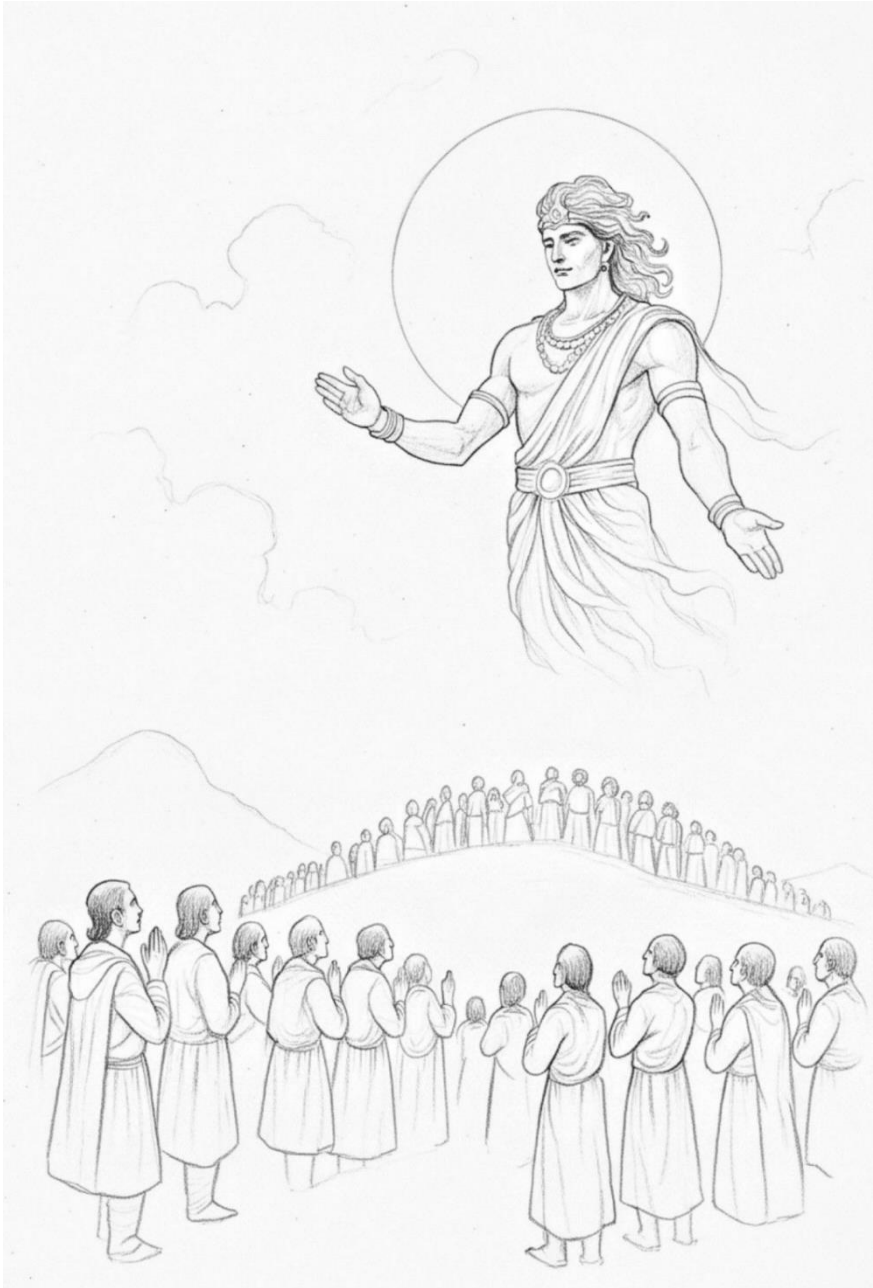
Shyaanveer then came out of his **hut** and asked all the **villagers** to sit. He began to recount what he had **witnessed**, informing

MER KINGDOM'S JOURNEY FROM INSIDE AND OUTSIDE AND A TRY TO FIND "EHEROSHENA".

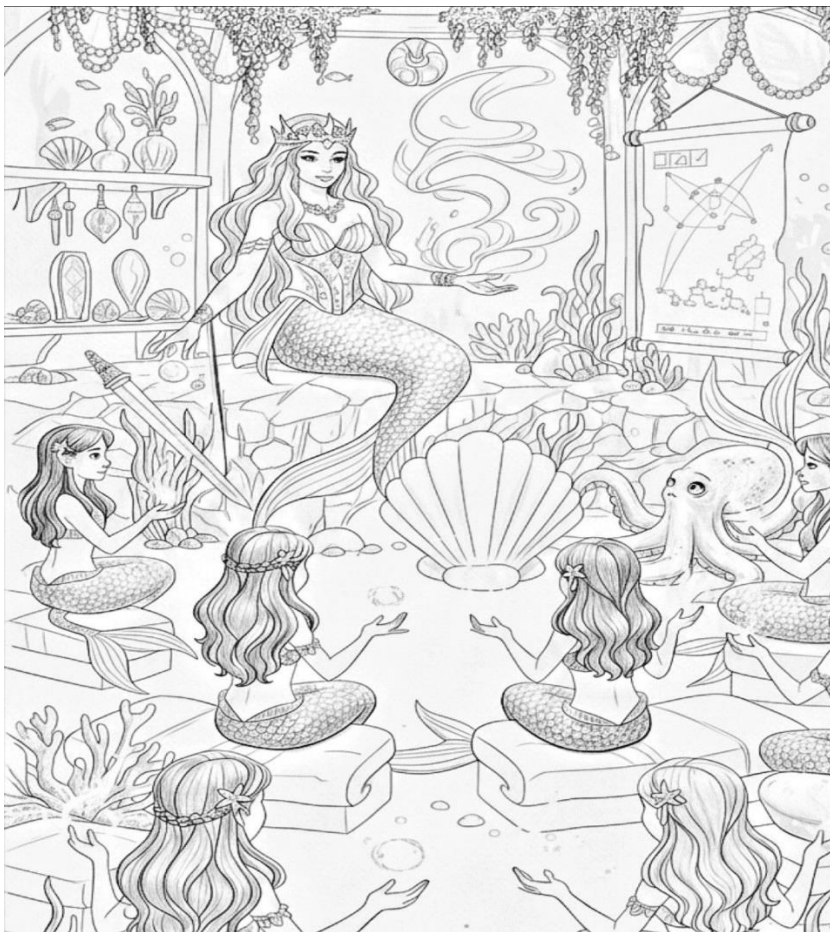

if she attains the power to become a **mermaid** and can then again revert to her **original form**.

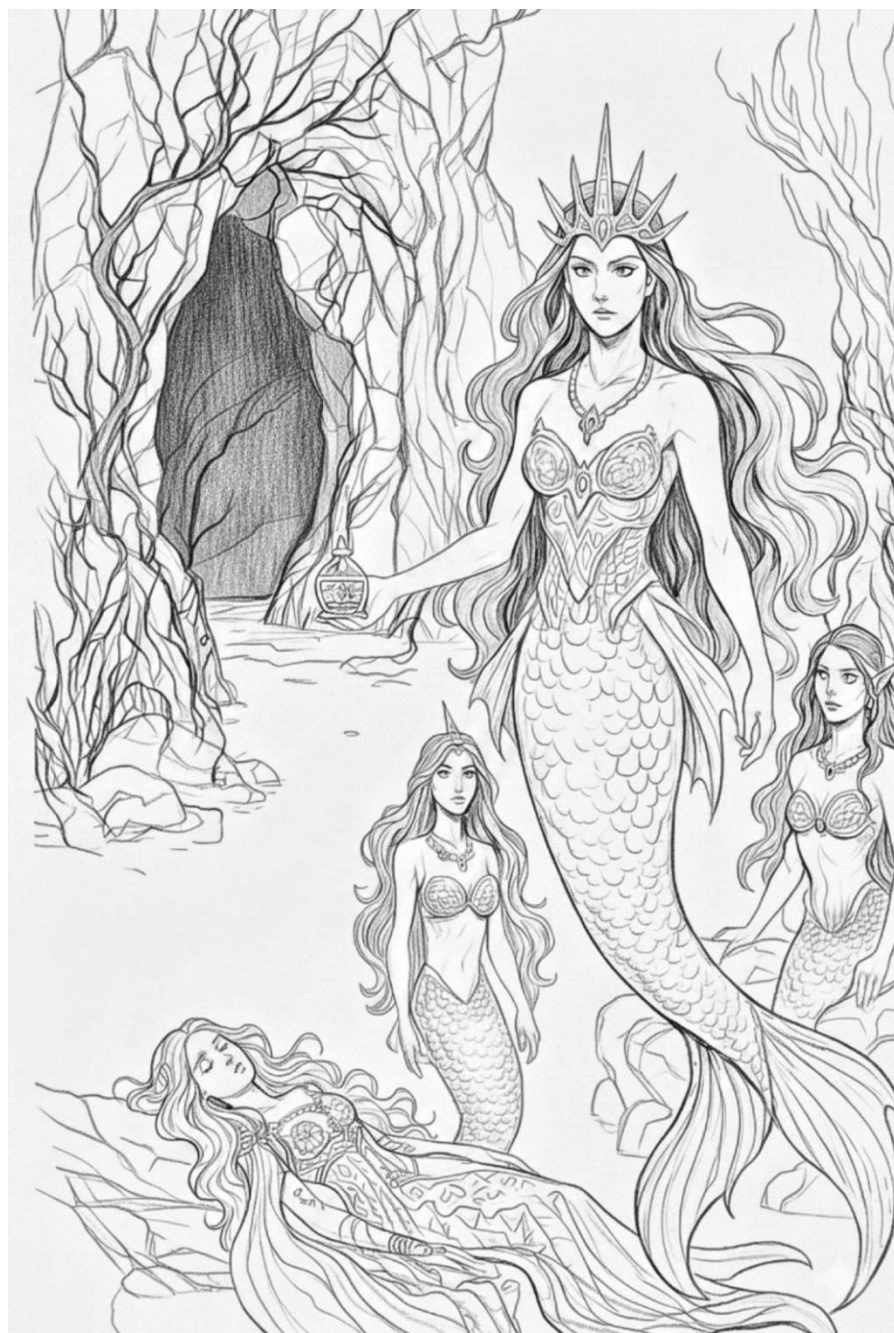

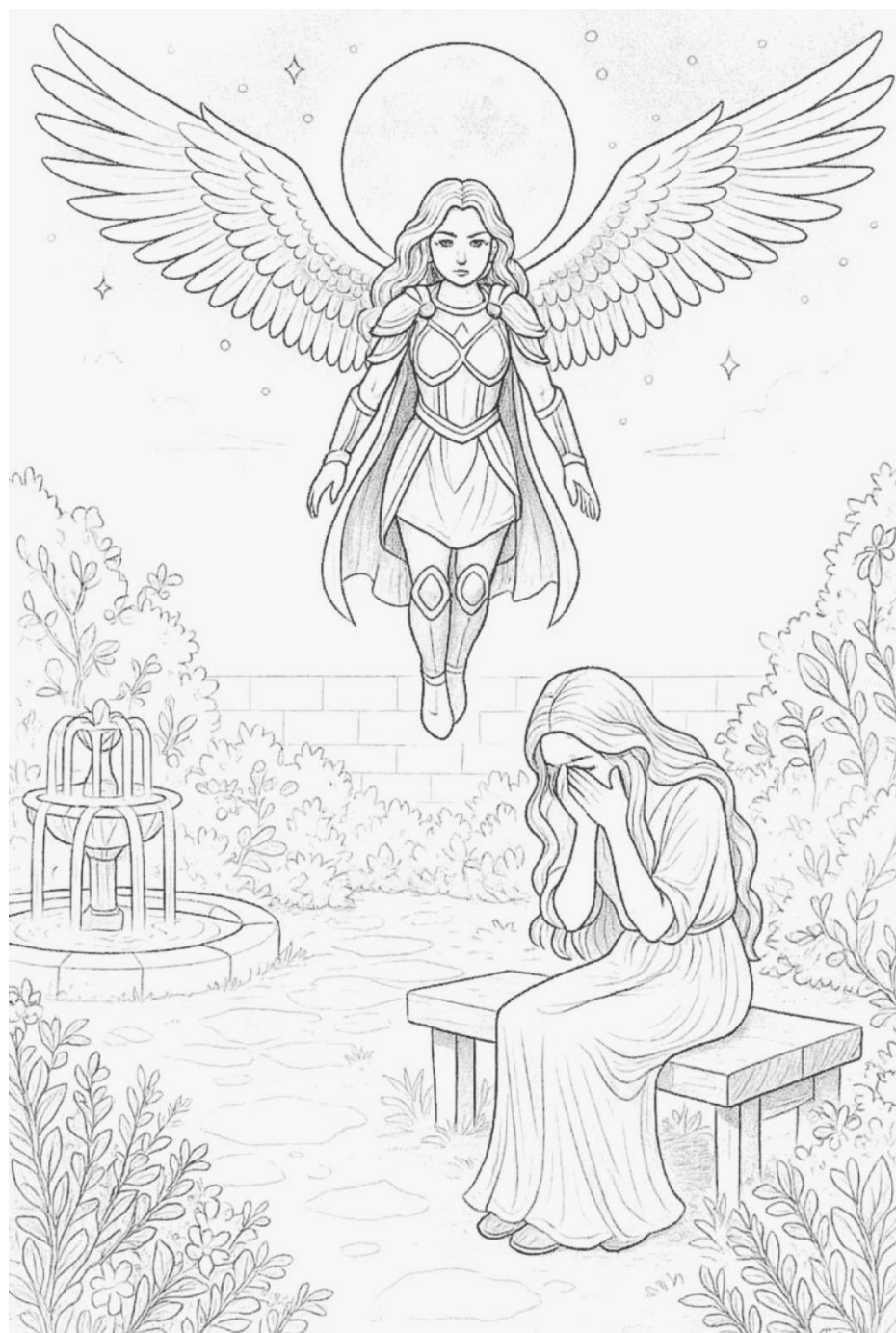
