You will discover each number's virtues and shortcomings. You will be astounded at how simple it is to effect the direction of your life since each of us has the capacity of free will to change the course of our destinies for better or worse. There are so many things that you can learn about each number. You'll discover the significance of colors and how they impact our lives. The following chapters will tell you which days of the week benefit your number and what jewels resonate with it.

You will learn how to choose the appropriate dwelling number and vehicle based on its number. "Remember, numbers reveal vibrations, and vibrations are the basis of all existence," This life of ours has a "pulse," and if we just stop for a second, we can feel it. You can grasp this numerology technique I'm writing about if you think in terms of vibrations. You will discover the importance of your name and what it symbolizes and learn to anticipate the outcome of specific events. You can plan your life more easily if you attentively follow each step.

Ever since the middle of the VIth Century, B.C., when Pythagoras gave the ancient Greeks his system of numbers, each succeeding age has been attracted, more or less, to his philosophy.

Each generation down the millennia has found the concept intriguing yet fantastical.

Some people are aware of its accuracy.

According to the old master's teaching, everything is in a state of vibration. The greater the rate of vibration, the more spirit force an object contains and the more positive its nature. The slower the rate of vibration, the less force it has and the more negatively it acts.

Before we continue, let me briefly explain why numbers are so important to us. The proverbs "his number was up" and "my days are numbered," among others, are ones we have all heard. Look around you at all the numbers; one is your house or apartment number. You will have a bank account number, a credit card number, a medical insurance number, and so on. There are numbers all around you that vibrate without your knowledge, but each has a function to play in life and pulses to its beat.

We rely on numbers today more than at any other moment in history. Computers are a reality, and they keep so much data in them that, at times, we are more of a number than a name. Whether we want it or not, we are constantly tracked by numbers "from the cradle to the cemetery."

Have you ever needed to provide identification to someone? If so, what was the situation? Did you notice that the individual attempting to verify your identification was satisfied when he received something with a number on it, even though your

name was sufficient? You are starting to understand what I mean when I say that since numbers play such a significant part in our lives, they shouldn't be taken for granted. In the following chapters, I'll offer you as much knowledge about numbers as possible so you can comprehend the vibrations in your life. Understanding how to balance your numbers will enable you to balance your life.

I wrote this book partly to dispel people's misconceptions about numbers. We may live more comfortably if we have a framework for understanding our life. The book shows the simplest of techniques; typically, the most fundamental concepts in life are the most difficult to understand.

I do not doubt that anyone who puts the system to the test will be amazed by the outcomes in a very short amount of time. Our lives will be in harmony if our numbers are harmonious (remember, numbers are a clue to the vibrations around us). So come along on a journey with me into the realm of numbers.

History of Evolution of Numerology:

Numerology is as old as human civilization. Every human civilization has its numerology system, which was present with them and later either vanished or was rediscovered in a different form.

The earliest traces of numerology evolution can be dated back to the late bronze age (Vedic Period (i.e., 4th – 6th Century BC)

The oldest direct reference to modern-day numerology can be found as old as the 1300s, and indirect references are even older.

There is no need to compare two systems of numerology or two branches of occult sciences, as each has its attributes, pros, and cons.

Some of the Numerology systems

- *Chaldean Numerology*: Attributed to Babylonians. They did not consider the number nine while assigning a number to the alphabet. Nine is considered a sacred number; its attribute is “giving” and “humanity”. The ancients (including me and many others) believed that these attributes we learn as we grow and evolve.
- *Pythagorean Numerology*: Attributed to Pythagoras of Samos & Philolaus (Researcher from Pythagorean Community)
- *Lo Shu Grid Numerology*: Having inspiration from Yantras of Agam Granthas and attributed to South East Asian Countries of the modern day world.

Numerology has a long history that dates back thousands of years. Numerology was employed by the Chinese, Japanese, Greeks, Hebrews, Egyptians, Phoenicians, early Christians, Mayans, and Incas to understand various subjects, including the universe and themselves. Chaldean numerology differs significantly from one of the better-liked systems, Western Numerology, credited to Pythagoras (c. 500 BCE).

Instead of sound vibrations, the Pythagorean system is based on sequential patterns. The alphabet is listed in alphabetical order beneath a numbering system that ranges from 1 to 9.

One notable exception is the number 9. The ancient Chaldeans held this number in the highest regard; hence they did not include it in the number chart; however, they did include it as a name total. This number was revered by the ancients, probably in part because of its relationship to infinity (it is the only number that can be multiplied by any other number and always return to its original value), but Pythagoras paid it little attention, even giving its domain the letters I and R. Furthermore, Chaldean numerology only considers the name you are presently using, as opposed to the birth or given name because it is those energies that are affecting you right now rather than those you held in the past. Name changes are another factor to take into account here. Names may change, changing energy vibrations, whether by necessity or choice- adoption, marriage, divorce, or even the creation of nicknames.

The easiest occult art to comprehend and apply is numerology. To uncover all the mysteries the numbers contain, you only need the person's full name and birth date. (Most experts concur that all computations regarding names must be performed using your full birth name as it appears on your birth certificate). However, Chaldean experts believe in using the birth

certificate and the more widely used or known name. Chaldean use sound vibration.

To create Numerology charts, eleven numbers are utilized. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, and 22 are the numbers in question. You keep reducing the numbers until you have a single digit or the “master” numbers 11 or 22. These numerical values each stand for various traits and expressions.

The lone exception to the general norm of reducing to a single digit are the master numbers. They are not reduced to single digits. The single-digit number that the master numbers 11 and 22 replace are intensified versions of that number (2 and 4). These figures point to the possibility of significant learning and/or achievement, frequently in a more demanding setting.

In a numerology chart, the results of multiple calculations are presented rather than only focusing on one specific number. The relationships between these statistics are then looked at and analyzed. Numerology is also quite easy to understand.

You can actually “do it yourself” because it is so easy.

LET’S GET GOING!

Primary Figures Extracted from the Birth Date:

The Life Path Number, Expression Number, Soul Desire/Urge Number, and Personality Number are among the fundamental numbers generated from the date of birth.

The sum of the birth date is used to calculate the life path number. It depicts a person's life path or the challenges and possibilities put in front of them. This secondary number is thought to be very important in later life.

Birth date: 15 November 1980

$$15+11+1980 = 1+5+1+1+1+9+8+0 = 26/8$$

8 is the Life Path number.

The soul urge number reflects a person's inner motivations and desires. It is derived from the name's total vowel sound.

A person's personality number represents their external demeanor and the impression they give off to others. It is generated from the name's consonant count. This number represents a person's potential for success and accomplishment in life.

Birth Compound Number: This number applies to anyone born after the ninth day of any month.

The two-digit birth dates have their significance, influence, and meaning.

For instance:

Birth date: November 15, 1980

Birth Number: $1 + 5 = 6$

15 is the birth compound no.



CHAPTER 2

BIRTHDATES & THEIR CHARACTERISTICS

1st of the Month:

Individuals born on the 1st of the month benefit from pure one energy. They acquire reason, drive, excitement, independence, and analytical skills. They are likely to suppress their feelings out of concern that they will appear weak. They naturally take on leadership roles and relish chances to show off their abilities.

2nd of the Month:

Individuals born on the 2nd of the month are warm, loving, giving, romantic, sentimental, perceptive, and on occasion, moody. They frequently experience anxiety. They occasionally get depressed and require the ongoing support of others. They would rather collaborate with others than operate alone.

3rd of the Month:

Individuals born on the 3rd of the month are typically very well-liked and extroverted, imaginative, gregarious, communicative, and show all the delights of life. They frequently ideate better than they execute. They usually have multiple significant relationships throughout their lives and are restless. They have a gift for language and will probably do best in any occupation where they can use it: teaching, consulting, and sales.

4th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 4th of the month tend to be organized and appreciate a challenge. They also deeply love their families, homes, and nations. They are diligent, willing to put in much effort and wait patiently for what they want.

5th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 5th of the month are adaptable and extroverted with a free lifestyle. They lack focus as they continuously learn new things. These folks frequently succeed in business. They are intelligent, gregarious, social, and well-adjusted individuals.

6th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 6th of the month tend to be optimistic, kind, and humanitarian.

In general, they are happiest while assisting others. They relish the obligations of marriage and parenthood. They don't hesitate to express their emotions to others.

7th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 7th of the month are perceptive, sensitive, and like to solve problems on their own. They prefer working alone while conducting research and studying. Though harbouring deep emotions, tenderness is difficult to express and receive for them.

8th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 8th of the month make excellent business people. They love dealing with money and the financial world and have great ideas for money-making. They possess ambition, drive, and common sense and are willing to put in a lot of effort to achieve their goals as long as they believe the goals are worthwhile.

9th of the Month:

10th of the Month:

11th of the Month:

They are positive, quick to act, and can lead themselves and others with their inspirational ideas. They change their minds often, get separated from their partners, and have frequent ups and downs in their feelings. Those who were born on the 11th of any month often have brilliant ideas, but they are rarely able to see them through to completion. Although these individuals possess exceptional intuition and talent, their anxiety and tense personalities make it difficult to accomplish their objectives.

12th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 12th of the month benefit from both the energies of 1 (Sun) and 2 (Moon). Compared to persons born on the third of the month, they are more complex, swinging between extremes; cheerful, optimistic, understanding, and humane at one time and exactly the opposite at other times. Careless about others’ feelings, they often embellish reality and persuade others to agree with them and their thoughts. They make delightful, entertaining, and knowledgeable conversationalists.

13th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 13th of the month have the combination of 1 (Sun) and 3 (Jupiter), giving an irritable nature. This number indicates changes in one's plans and place but is not as unfortunate as it is made out to be. It is a number of alert, practical and dependable people. Those who were born on the thirteenth of the month are diligent, methodical, and have great potential for achievement. They use caution and are steadfast, disciplined, and tenacious. They can easily go to the depth of matters.

14th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 14th of the month are adventurous, bold, adaptive, and open-minded. It is a karmic compound of 1 (Sun) and 4 (Rahu). Rahu partially eclipses the Sun and causes difficulties. Number 14 people suffer from inner conflicts. Fourteen-borns should guard against natural calamities. They are intuitive by nature. Refraining from alcohol, drugs, and excessive sex will do them well. When necessary, they may work incredibly hard and enjoy working with others, but rarely put in lengthy hours.

15th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 15th of the month have intellect, ready wit, material success, literature, fine arts, and popularity. These people are also loyal and understanding. Having an innate sense that when someone needs a shoulder to lean on, they are the first ones to

provide the same. They are affectionate, gregarious, and amiable, yet desire to maintain a certain level of independence.

16th of the Month:

17th of the Month:

18th of the Month:

strife in life. This number gives family feuds, enmities, betrayal from friends, and no peace and happiness. But they face challenges and adverse situations boldly.

19th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 19th of the month are associated with responsibility, ideals, and ambition. Because their emotions always triumph over logic, they occasionally let themselves down. It is a very lucky number showering happiness and success on the native. They are adaptable and prefer to operate independently with the least amount of outside disturbance, putting in a lot of effort and long hours.

20th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 20th of the month are impatient, nervous, shy, and dependent. They favour tranquil lifestyles and try to stay away from the bustle of modern life as much as possible. They frequently write effectively to convey their point of view. Married life may not be all that successful.

21st of the Month:

22nd of the Month:

25th of the Month:

Individuals born on the 25th of the month have this not-so-fortunate combination. The Moon is neutral to Mercury, but Mercury sends out unfriendly vibes toward the Moon. Individuals born on the 25th of the month are sensitive, perceptive, and philosophical and require alone time. They are lucky in love and make substantial financial gains, especially by marriage. Because they are sensitive, when they get upset, they often become distant. They are difficult to become close to, but your friendship with them will continue forever once you become close.

26th of the Month:

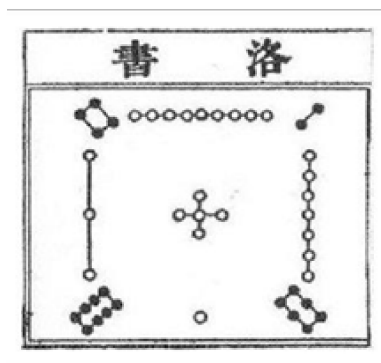

The Old Chinese philosophers and religious thinkers, in spite of their traditional reverence for the written word, often left ideas unsaid, or only indirectly expressed—either because they and their fellow scholars took them for granted or because the fuller exposition formed part of the esoteric learning that was orally transmitted from teacher to disciple. Some of the key ideas they did not explicitly set down were expressed in various symbols, but, again, they seldom passed on the meanings of these in books, probably for similar reasons. However, an important symbol can sometimes be deciphered by the process of patient analysis, with constant reference to contemporary books and surviving traditions;

and, when this is successful, the recovered meanings not only can often serve to supplement the literary texts of that time but may also uncover forgotten traditions, thus giving us new knowledge of the old ideas and beliefs.

A simple diagram from Old China, commonly known as Lo Shu, provides a good example of how well a good symbol reflects the principal idea of its time. It can convey several meanings simultaneously and inspire new ways of thinking.

For over a thousand years, the world of Chinese scholarship has known the Lo Shu as this simple pattern composed of black and white circles or dots arranged in nine groups containing one to nine units each.

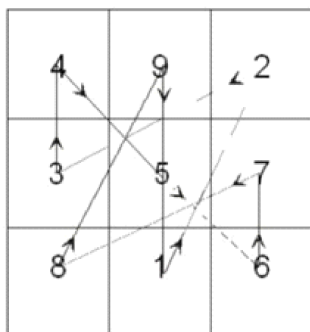


An ancient form of divination, Chinese numerology dates back about 4,000 years. The birth of this art form is retold in the Legend of the Turtle.

The mythical Emperor Yu ruled between 2205 and 2198 B.C.E. He had a reputation for being

wise and ruling justly. At one time, Emperor Yu was engaged in the supervision of building a dam on the Yellow River. Sitting by the bank of the river, he was interrupted by a divine turtle that appeared from the river.

The emperor was astonished when he took a closer look at the back of the Turtle. There was a magic square, nine numbers in all. The numbers added up to 15 in every direction.



Lo Shu grid is a square-shaped design that consists of 9 numbers from 1 to 9 with three rows and three columns. The total of each row and each column sums to 15. It is considered a sacred square. Chinese numerology has always been associated with the Magical Lo Shu Grid, discovered around 4000 years ago. The intrinsic patterns of the base chart and the way the numbers move about the grid are believed to offer clues on the characteristics and outcomes of events within the environment. The Lo Shu grid is the central principle behind “Flying Star Feng Shui” and is also used to interpret individual birth charts.

In those ancient times in China, it was considered an auspicious omen because they believed that God lived inside tortoise and turtle shells. From this quasi-historical tale, the diagram came to be called the Lo Shu, meaning “Lo River Writing” or “Document of the Lo River” or sometimes simply “Turtle Writing.” It was even referred to as the “River Plan.” The Lo Shu was also described as “The Celestial Numbers of the Nine Halls.” About the beginning of the 2nd century BC, in an early mathematics book by Hsu Yo, a noted astronomer of the Ch’in and Han dynasty, the first reference to the “Nine Halls Calculation” was found in a section on various forms of divination. Again, in the 6th century AD, a commentary by Taoist Chên Luan referred to the Nine Halls by the quotation, 2 and 4 make the shoulders, 6 and 8 make the feet; 3 is at the left, 7 is at the right, 9 is worn on the head, and 1 is underfoot; while five dwells at the center.

The diagram below illustrates the relationship between the eight-sided Pa-Kua and Lo-Shu magic square’s nine grids. Please note that the Pa-Kua shown here places the direction of South at the top, to correspond with the number 9. This is because the Chinese compass places South at the top, and to ensure consistency and accuracy, it is necessary when relationships between symbols are being analyzed, and to comply with the practice followed in the ancient manuals.

For practical purposes, however, you may use modern compasses, which place North at the top. However, it is vital that mistakes should not be made while attempting to make an interpretation based on the symbolic relationship between numbers and Trigrams.

The Chinese give equal importance to the Lo-Shu square as they do to the Pa-Kua. It is derived from Laxmi Yantra, similar to the one on the back of the tortoise considered to be the 2nd incarnation of Lord Vishnu.

The square is also called a magic square and is believed to give important information while analyzing the building/destiny of the person. Let's look closer at the square and try to see its significance.

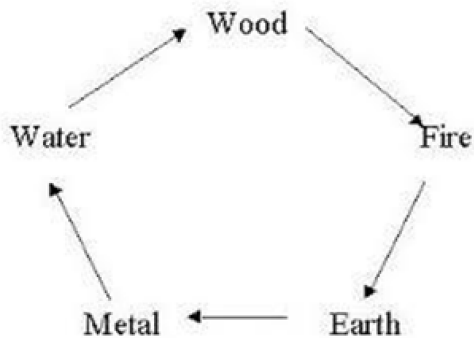

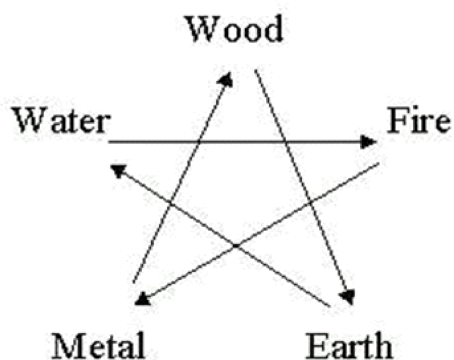


Explaining the Productive Cycle:

CHAPTER 5

HOW TO USE LO SHU GRID

The Magical Lo Shu grid is divided equally into six parts. Three vertically and three horizontally, respectively. It is also called The LPG (Life Pattern Grid), and there are many ways to look at it.

The numbers 4, 9, and 2 in the top row show the head of a person. The middle row, which has the numbers 3, 5, and 7 is the body. The last row, with the numbers 8, 1, and 6 is for the feet.

- The top row could be called the **Mental/Spiritual plane**. It includes thinking, making, imagining, and figuring out. Having to do with Head.
 - Sharp brain
 - Good memory

- Intellectual skills
- Intuitive
- **The emotional plane** is the row in the middle.
 - spirituality,
 - Intuition,
 - Feelings, and emotions.
 - Also linked to the Torso.
- The plane on the bottom row is called **Practical Plane**
 - ability to do physical work
 - Creativity
 - Capacity to be good at sports, have good physical coordination, and be useful in everyday life. To use the head-legs analogy, the feet of the Practical Plane are firmly on the ground.

In the same way, the vertical columns can be understood as follows:

- The **Thought plane** is the first of these vertical columns.
 - This shows how good the person is at coming up with ideas, making things, and seeing them through to the end.
 - Sharp brain.
 - Good planning capability
- The **Will plane** is the middle column.
 - This gives the drive and determination to succeed.

- Good willpower and self-confidence
- Executes the task
- The last column on the right is the **Action plane**.
 - This shows that the person can put his ideas into action.
 - Good physical energy
 - Takes quick decisions in life.

The three columns go in a logical order. First, the person needs to think of an idea (Thought plane). He (or she) needs to be determined and keep trying, or the idea will never be put into action. At this point, plans are made. Lastly, the person needs to be able to act on the idea and the desire (Action plane).

How to apply Lo-Shu Grid. Let’s take one example of birth date 13th August 1967:

Life purpose number comes to

Place the number of dates of birth and life purpose number in the Lo-Shu square as shown: We also have to add the Kua number, which we will do after the relevant chapter.

This grid is prepared from the full date of birth. The number grid gives 100% vibration and power.

Horizontal & Vertical Arrows:

You should have figured out by now that the rows on the grid are important because they have different numbers. According to Chinese numerology, the following are the meanings of the different arrows.

Most of the arrows in the system were one of two types. The Arrow of Will Power/Determination:

The numbers 8, 5, and 2 make up this arrow. People who have this arrow are patient, determined, and don't give up easily. They're happy to wait until the right time and then act. They never lose sight of their goals, no matter what happens. Also referred to as Success Plane 2. They are good listeners. Slowly and steadily, they acquire properties.

The Arrow of Emotional Balance:

This is the number 4, 5, and 6 on the chart. It follows the path of the era of emotional balance. Also, referred to as Success Plane 1. People with this trait are kind, caring, and often make a living by helping other people. They are sensitive and intuitive, and achieve success. These people can seem shy, especially when they are young because they are quiet and gentle.

The Arrow of Wisdom/Intellect (Mental Plane):

In the first row across, the arrow is made up of the numbers 4, 9, and 2. If you have these three numbers, you will be smart and have a good memory. People with this arrow are smart, articulate, and logical, but sometimes they think they are better than other people.

The Arrow of Frustration (absence of 2, 5, 8):

This arrow indicates that there have been numerous difficulties and setbacks. It is viewed as an indication of failure repeatedly. Individuals with this missing arrow should aim to learn from every event and carefully consider their actions before taking action.

The Arrow of Suspicion (absence of 4, 5, 6):

This arrow represents those who are distrustful, cynical, and irritable.

They tend to worry and focus on the unpleasant aspects of life.

This arrow points to a "grey individual."

Indicates a person who lives in perpetual darkness and never sees the light of day.

The Arrow of Loneliness/Skepticism (absence of 3, 5, 7):

This arrow represents a lack of emotion. Individuals with this arrow are so focused on accomplishing their objectives that they neglect their friends and family, and as a result, their lives lack happiness, love, and laughter. People typically suffer from extreme loneliness in their old life. This occurs when 3, 5, and 7 are missing from the grid. They typically hold a conservative view of religion and spirituality. These individuals are caring, trustworthy, and fair, yet they are unable to express themselves. They are born idealistic and highly perceptive.

The Arrow of Apathy (absence of 2, 6, 7):

This arrow is generated when the last vertical row of the chart is missing the numbers 2, 6, and 7. Those afflicted with apathy lack drive and fail to seize opportunities knocking at their door. These individuals are indecisive, fearful of taking risks, and have generally accomplished only a fraction of what they could if they exerted more effort.

The Arrow of Confusion (absence of 4, 3, 8):

This missing arrow shows up because there are no 8, 3, or 4 in the chart. It is in the leftmost vertical column. People who have this arrow are not logical, organized, or methodical.

They don't make plans for more than a few days ahead and then self-sabotage their own plans.

The Arrow of Losses (absence of 8, 1, 6):

This arrow is made when the numbers 8, 1, and 6 are not in the bottom row. So, this Arrow hasn't been on anyone's charts in the 20th century, but it will be back in the 21st century. People like these will try to make money by taking part in easy get-rich schemes. They will always fail at these things, and they won't realize it until they are middle-aged. If they had put the same amount of work into a single worthwhile goal, they would have been successful.

The Arrow of Uncertainty/Indecision (9, 5, 1):

This is because the numbers 1, 5 and 9 are not in the middle vertical row. No one has this arrow born in the 1900s. Now, many people will be having this missing arrow of weakness.

People with this arrow really want to be liked and accepted. So, it's easy for others to lead and change them. They will have a hard time standing up for what they believe in because they want everyone to like them and can't say things that other people might not agree with.

The Arrow of Poor Memory (absence of 2, 4, 9):

The lack of the numbers 4, 9 and 2 in the top horizontal row results in the arrow. The 31st century will be the time when this arrow will appear again. In their birth chart, everyone born in the previous century had a 9 and everyone born in the following century will have a 2.

This arrow indicates that an individual's intellectual capacity is robust early in life but gradually declines as they get older. These folks can have mental instability and are regularly overcome by the intensity of their ideas.

The four middle numbers of the outside horizontal and vertical rows are joined to form these four little arrows. These tiny arrows connect the numbers 1 and 3, 3 and 9, 9 and 7, and 7 and 1, respectively.

The Hint of Deception and Detail (1, 3):

When both a 1 and a 3 are present on the chart, this row is produced. This combination makes people detail-oriented. In fact, if any number appears more than once, the individual has a tendency towards perfectionism. The arrow also has a negative aspect. In an effort to safeguard themselves, they might fabricate information or hide the facts.

The Litigation Arrow (3, 9):

When the chart has both the 3 and 9 numbers, this arrow is produced. This combination makes people more likely to debate and get embroiled in conflicts of all types. This combination is known as the arrow of litigation because if these

issues become too serious, they must be resolved in court.

The Peace of Mind Arrow (7, 9):

People with this combination are optimistic, self-assured, and have a firm faith. The arrow is formed when the chart contains both a 9 and a 7. The spirituality of the 7 benefits from the rationality of the 9, and vice versa. This constituency is capable of responding to various circumstances with composure and faith that things will turn out for the best.

The Arrow of Science (1, 7):

Individuals whose birth charts include the numbers 1 and 7 are curious about the wonders of our universe. They adore looking for the hidden facts and can get bogged down in their research if they let it. Often, they have an interest in the sciences (frequently those that concern the oceans).

Missing Numbers in Detail:**Number 1:**

People who don't have the number one will find it hard to show who they are and what makes them

special. They will probably not have any issues with ego and pride, and they'll probably spend most of their time helping and supporting other people. People who are lazy or afraid may be unable to set career goals or miss opportunities when planning their careers. Their careers sometimes get in the way, and they can't take a different path.

Number 2:

add to that particular year. This can be done for any year an individual wants to know. Take the example of 27th May. I add it to the present year of 2023. $2+7+5+2+0+2+3=21=2+1=3$. The personal year of this individual in 2023 is 3. This year will vibrate with number 3 energies.

Let us use MH 43 BE 5682 as an example.

First, there is the number as a whole. We get this number by adding up the digits and the letter values that go with them.

$$4+5+4+3+2+5+5+6+8+2=44=8$$

The second is the sum of the numbers unique to the person

$$5+6+8+2=21=3$$

Third is the sum of the letters: $4+5+2+5=16=7$

The numbers stand out the most and show how people see you. The total of the letters tells you about the purpose and type of trip, while the overall numbers tells you about the vehicle. If you aren't compatible with these numbers, you

may have trouble getting where you want to go in life. People are slowly learning how important it is to buy their own personalised number plate because of this.

MH 43 BE is common to many. 5682 is unique to the person in the example taken.

Ideal case should be that the unique and common numbers combined should be friendly to you.

Practically, at least the unique total should be friendly.

Number 1: Very single minded driver. Always on the move and a good driver.

Number 2: This number makes you think a little too much about other drivers. A considerate driver.

Number 3: You like to drive. You might go out a lot to have fun. The car can be personalised and flashy.

Number 4: You may have a car that is well taken care of. You care about how things work. Don't worry too much about how clean the car is.

Number 5: The temptation here is to multitask while you drive. Make sure that you have a hands free mobile.

Number 6: Very good for a family car, for going on outings and everything to do with community work.

Number 7: You tend to go into a world of your own. Must be mindful while driving.

Number 8: Be calm while you drive and get a hands free set. You love driving an impressive set of wheels.

Relevance of your Mobile Numbers:

Another very important number in our life is our mobile number. It can also be called our identity as we are giving out our numbers to people, all the time. We are in touch with the outside world through our mobile phones. If our birth number or destiny number is not in harmony with our mobile number, or we are not getting enough calls we would like to get, it could be worth changing the same, to get the desired results.

Any number which is associated with you for a very long time impacts us, colours our life. Be it house number or mobile number or landline number. You arrive at it the same way as all other numbers - by adding all the digits and reducing it to a single number. However, notice the individual digits also because if one or two of them repeats several times it can impact the final number. It is always better to prepare a mobile number grid, along with date of birth grid, and name grid. And, then compare all three grids.

Mobile Number 1:

You are left to your own devices most of the time. This number is not ideal for chatting, relaxed, frank and social communications.

Mobile Number 2:

You will probably be called to ask for advice most of the times. People will look up to you as the one to sort their issues. Expect heart to heart chat on this number.

Mobile Number 3:

Mobile Number 4:

CHAPTER 11

KUA NUMBER

In Feng Shui, Kua Number is an important idea. In Lo Shu also it is used extensively to find out about our lucky directions. The Date of Birth and Gender of a person are used to figure out their Kua number. Feng shui says that a person’s birth year has an effect on some of their qualities, skills, and other traits. It’s also known as the Eight Mansions or Eight Houses of Feng Shui. Your Kua Number may also be called your bagua number, or personal trigram.

What is My Kua Number?

Once you know your kua number, it’s easy to find the best compass directions for your work, love, health, wealth, and other parts of your life. Four of the eight mansions (the eight compass directions) will be good luck, and four will be bad luck. With this information, you can improve all parts of your life and stay away from directions that aren’t good for your kua number.

To calculate anyone's feng shui kua number, you will need the following information:

- The year they were born that is the Birth Year
- Gender- Male/Female
- Convert DOB in Chinese calendar. Usually, February 4 is the Chinese new year.
- If you are born after February 4, consider your actual date of birth. Example: 20.06.2020, we will consider 2020 as the birth year.
- Born on 30.01.2021. Consider the year of birth one year prior, 30.01.2020

Kua Number

Step 1- Take last two digits of Year from Date of Birth

Step 2 – Subtract it from 10

July 1956 = 5+6 = 11 = 2

If you get Kua number as 5, consider it as number 8

Feng Shui Kua number & the two groups

Kua Number divides people into 2 groups. The Feng Shui Kua Number divides people into East and West groups.

People, whose Kua number is 1, 3, 4, 9 or a 5 male belong to the East group.

Those, whose Kua number is 2, 6, 7, 8 or a 5 female belong to the West group.

Understanding one's Feng Shui Kua Number will help us determine the best areas for us and identify the best elements, lucky colours, lucky

number, lucky seasons and lucky directions, thereby creating a positive mental attitude within ourselves.

CHAPTER 12

MEANING OF KUA NUMBERS



Kua Number 1

Component: Water

Harmonious with Black and Blue

Metallics and white are considered lucky colours.

Your element is water as your kua number is 1. Wear hues that symbolise water, such as blue or black. Wear white or metallic to increase your luck since, according to Feng Shui, metal creates water.

Auspicious Directions for Kua Number 1:

Success: Southeast:

Plants with rounded leaves, such as money plants, should be positioned in this direction.

- Position a Chinese dragon so that it faces this way.
- Position a “Wealth Toad,” a three-legged frog, facing this way. A coin ought to be in its mouth. Never let this frog face the front door.

Put a Laughing Buddha or any god who attracts prosperity here.

Health: East:

Put a Chinese dragon facing that way. But, avoid putting it in the bedroom.

Any type of water feature should be positioned in this direction. It aids in health improvement.

- Crystals should be hung or displayed in this direction to improve health.

Relationships: South:

Hang a picture of a phoenix to strengthen the bond.

To enhance romance in life, place pictures of peony flowers or a pair of Mandarin Ducks in this direction.

Wisdom: North:

This direction brings stability in life.

Place a “Monkey Turtle” in this direction.

Statues of Elephants represent wisdom and steadiness.

Inauspicious Directions:

A common remedy to neutralize this effect is to use this area as little as possible.

Frustration: West:

Convert this area into a storeroom or toilet.

Never place any earth elements like crystals or clay pots in this area.

Display pictures of swimming fishes over here.

Loss/Theft: Northeast:

Put any brass object there, preferably a Brass Kuan Yin, and hang six I Ching coins on red threads to counteract the negativity.

Disease: Northwest:

- In this location, use precious gourds.
- Install an idol of the Eight Immortals here. It stands for prosperity and joy.

Total Loss: Southwest:

- Do not open any windows or doors that face this way. Keep them shut.
- To neutralise the negative energy, position a Laughing Buddha in this direction.

Kua Number 2

Kua number 2's element is Earth

Yellows and beiges are colours that go together (think "earth tones")

Colors that Bring Good Luck: blazing hues like red and purple

Your kua number is 2, which indicates that earth is your element. Wear hues that reflect earth tones, such as beige or yellow. Fire creates earth according to Feng Shui, thus if you wish, Wear purple or red to increase your luck.

Auspicious Directions for Kua number 2:**Success: Northeast:**

- When performing critical tasks, face this direction.

- Position images of carp fish in this way because they represent wealth.
- Position your head to face this way while you sleep.
- Clutter should not be present.
- The home's front door should face this way.

Health: West:

- Exquisite gourds stand for longevity and excellent health. In the northwest corner, hang these.
- Sleep with your head on this side. The bedroom should be located in the house's westernmost corner.

Relationships: Northwest:

Place a pair of Mandarin Ducks in this direction.

To symbolize healthy relationships, place a tortoise.

Wisdom: Southwest:

Place elephant statues.

Meditating in this corner will be beneficial.

Place a crystal globe in this area and give it a spin from time to time to activate personal growth.

Inauspicious Directions:

A common remedy to neutralize this effect is to use this area as little as possible.

Frustration: East:

Display pictures of mountains in this area.

No display of water feature

Avoid this area as much as possible.

Loss/Theft: Southeast:

Earth elements, like porcelain vases or clay figurines can be displayed here.

Place Kuan Kung and the four Heavenly Kings. They protect from fraudulent people.

Disease: South:

The head should not be pointed in this direction while working or sleeping, and crystals should not be placed here.

Total Loss: North:

- Don't perform any actions in this direction.
- Avoid residing in a home with the main door facing in this direction.

No water feature should be positioned in this direction.

- If one must work in this direction, set up a statue of Kuan Kung in the background.

Kua Number 3:

Component: Wood:

Colors that go together: brown and green (think "trees")

Black and watery blue hues are lucky colours.

Auspicious Directions for Kua number 3:

Success: South:

- Place a statue of horses on display, with golden ingots and I-Ching coins all around it.

- The front door of one's home or place of business should face this way.
- Position your head to sleep in this direction. To attract prosperity, face this way.

Health: North:

- Position your head to face this way while you sleep.
- Face any type of water feature, such as an aquarium, in this direction.

To improve the health circumstances, turn harmonious turtles in this direction.

This fortunate direction improves interpersonal harmony.

Relationships: Southeast:

Put a pair of wooden Mandarin ducks in this direction, as well as the Chinese scroll for love or the Rose Quartz Crystal Ducks.

Put any type of green plant here.

Wisdom: East:

- Display pictures of the green dragon here.
- Install a water feature here.
- Increase your time spent here.
- Position your head to face this way while you sleep.
- Set up the Three Star Gods and Jade here.

Inauspicious Directions:

This unlucky direction brings misfortune and trouble. Negative energy makes things harder and makes things fail.

Frustration: Southwest:

- If there is a door or window in this direction, do not use it.
- Hang an I Ching Coin sword.
- Avoid putting any earthen or crystal elements in this direction.

Loss/Theft: Northwest:

- Do not plant any flowers in this direction.
- Place a wind chime here.
- This region is perfect for installing a toilet.

I Ching Coins can be placed in this direction to counteract any negative energy.

Disease: Northeast:

- Keep aquariums away from this direction.

Temple Lions should be displayed in this direction.

If there is a bedroom in this direction, place six I Ching coins there.

Total Loss: West:

- Avoid using the doors that face this direction if you live in a home with that orientation.
- Point a wind chime made of I-Ching coins in this direction.
- No water feature should be positioned in this direction.
- Position a pair of Fu Dogs so that they are facing this way.

Kua Number 4:**Element: Green:**

Wood tones are the Harmonizing Colors (think “forest of trees”)

Colors that Bring Good Luck: Black and watery hues like blue

Success: North:

- If you're doing anything, turn your head in this way.
- To increase the positive energy, hang wind chimes (6 metal rods) in this direction.
- Face any water feature in this manner.
- Install Wealth Fish statues.

Health: South:

- If there is space, consider sleeping in this place to enhance your health.
- Put statues of Sau and Quan Yin, who represent enduring power.
- Utilize the doors that are positioned in this manner.

You can also plant bright red flowers in this way.

- Evergreen plants improve the South's Fire element.

Relationships: East:

- Add a statue of a Chinese dragon or any other type of water element here.

- Improving relationships with coworkers will result from working in this area.
- Put a pair of Mandarin ducks there to improve your love life.

Wisdom: Southeast:

- Research in this area. Increase your time spent in this area.
- Place a statue of the Wealth Fish or the Eight Immortals here.

Inauspicious Directions:

Frustration: Northwest:

- Set up a pair of Fu Dogs to counteract the bad energies of this direction.
- Never work sitting or facing this direction.
- Suspend crystal balls in this direction.

Loss/Theft: Southwest:

- Avoid working or spending time looking in this direction.
- Set up a Laughing Buddha or a Dragon Turtle here.

Disease: West:

A Lions Head plaque should be positioned in this direction.

No earth element should ever be placed in this direction.

To counteract its unfavourable vibe, make this place the restroom.

Total Loss: Northeast:

- Don't perform any work here.
- Add a statue of Kuan Kung or a wind chime in this location.

Kua Number 5 (Male & Female):

Kua Number 5 Male Element is Big Earth. Yellows and beige are the Harmonizing Colors (think "earth tones")

Colors that Bring Good Luck: blazing hues like red and purple

Auspicious Directions for Kua Number 5 Male:**Success: Northeast:**

- This area needs to be maintained tidily.
- crystal balls should be placed to increase the impact of this direction.
- To attract money, the front door of your home and place of business should face this direction.

Health: West:

To improve your health, sleep with your head in this position. It will be advantageous to have the bedroom in this region of the house.

To improve health conditions, hang Wuloo or priceless gourds in this direction.

Relationships: Northwest:

- Position the turtle in this area. It stands for a healthy long life.

- Position the Mandarin Ducks in the bedroom or northwest corner of the building.

Wisdom: Southwest:

- Place any type of water element, such as a fountain or aquarium, at this position.
- Place a dragon turtle on display. It will offer security and safety.
- Spin a crystal globe every day while it is on display at this location.

Inauspicious Directions:**Frustration: East:**

- Convert this space to a pantry or kitchen.
- This space will be made active by a water feature. Hence, never position it in this manner.
- Avoid moving in that direction.

Loss/Theft: Southeast is the Direction:

- Point a statue of Kuan Kung in this direction. It will offer defense against treachery.
- Place earthy objects here, like earthenware and porcelain vases, to symbolise the earth. This reduces the area's negative energy.
- Working in this direction will result in loss, therefore avoid doing so.

Build a storage space here, if you can, in the direction of the south. Use this region only as directed.

Number 5 Kua (female)

Element: Earth:

Luck-Boosting Colors: flamboyant hues such as scarlet and purple.

Success: Southwest:

- Display a picture of nine carp fish. It generates revenue.
- To activate the positive energy of this area, place riches symbols such as Pi Yao, coins set, and golden ingots there.
- Set up a three-legged frog exhibit here. It shouldn't, however, face the front door.

Health: Northwest:

- Turn this space into a bedroom. A healthy life will result from it.

A tortoise should be positioned in this direction as it represents a healthy, long life.

Relationship: West:

Facing west in order to strengthen your bonds with others.

- Put a pair of Mandarin ducks there.

- Position images of peony blooms in this way as well.

Wisdom: Northeast:

- Set a crystal globe there to amp up the positive energy of this direction. Twirl it daily.

Inauspicious Directions for Kua Number 5 Female**Frustration: South:**

Do not use this area all that much

Put a crystal or semi precious stone to reduce the negative energy.

Loss/Theft: North:

Place wooden objects to reduce the negative energy.

Avoid working or sitting in the area.

Disease: East:

This direction is good for a storeroom or kitchen.

No water feature in this area.

Total Loss: Southeast:

Do not use this area.

If the main door of the house faces this direction then do not buy this property.

Hang a picture of a phoenix in this area.

Kitchen or storeroom is okay over here.

Kua Number 6:

Element; Metal

White and Silver are the Harmonizing Colors (think “metallic”)

Earth tones like yellows, beiges, taupes, and purple are lucky colours

Success: West:

- Use this location for the office workstation to draw in additional income.
- The home’s front door should face in this way.
- Use a three-legged frog to draw in additional business. It shouldn’t be facing the entrance.

Health: Northeast:

If there is space, consider sleeping in this portion of the house.

To enhance your health, place a crystal Lotus in this direction.

Relationships: Southwest:

To enhance partnerships, hang a pair of Mandarin Ducks or a Jade Double Happiness Charm in this location.

- Set a crystal globe there and spin it.

Wisdom: Northwest:

From here, hang a wind chime using six metal rods.

Display a dragon turtle or a laughing Buddha in this direction.

Inauspicious Directions:

Frustration: Southeast:

- There shouldn’t be any clutter in this space.

- Kuan Kung's statue ought to be kept facing this way.
- Avoid placing a moving clock in this area as it will activate the negative energy.

Loss/Theft: East:

- Don't rest or do anything in this area.
- Set up a pair of Qi Lin in this location.

Disease: North:

- Avoid setting up your desk in this direction.
- Avoid putting in any water features.

Large, leafy plants should be positioned in this direction.

Total Loss: South:

- Avoid using anything that includes the fire element. It stirs up the bad energy.
- Display items made of the element earth.

Kua Number 7:**Element: Metal:**

Harmonizing Colors: White and Silver (think "metallics")

Luck-Boosting Earth tones including yellows, beiges, taupes, and purple are used as colours.

Success: Northwest:

Both the front door of the house and the office should face this way. That will lead to achievement.

- Point a laughing Buddha or Chinese dragon in this direction.

- Work facing this direction or spend time in this direction.
- Set up a pair of Qi Lins facing this way.

Health: Southwest:

- Place your head in this direction
- Exhibit items made of earthy materials, such as pots or semiprecious stones.
- Use the door if it is facing this direction.
- Set a pair of Wuloo beside the bed.

Relationships: Northeast:

- Place a pair of Mandarin ducks in this position or hang a Chinese scroll depicting them.
- Jade or Rose Quartz Hearts. In addition, the Double Happiness Charm can be used.

Wisdom: West:

Place sculptures or paintings of tigers or elephants facing west in this direction.

You can also put the Tortoises of Harmony in this way.

Inauspicious Directions:**Frustration: North:**

- Keep clocks away from this location.
- Keep this space spotless.
- To stop the bad energy, place a pair of Qi Lins or a Laughing Buddha there.

Loss/Theft: South:

- This area is not a good place to sleep.

- Set five crystal lotuses or clear crystal quartz semi-precious stones in this location.
- Maintain a clay pot loaded with rice in this location.
- Set up a statue of Quan Yin to counteract the bad energy.

Disease: Southeast:

- Avoid holding meetings while looking in this direction.
- Never open a door that faces in this direction to enter a home.
- Set up a statue of Kuan Kung to counteract the bad energy.

Total Loss: East:

- Avoid going in that direction.
- Include a kitchen in this space, if at all possible.
- Neither the front door of the house nor the office should face in this direction.

Kua Number 8**Element: Earth:**

the colours yellow and beige are its harmonies (think “earth tones”)

Luck-Boosting Colors: flamboyant hues such as scarlet and purple

Success: Southwest:

- Put a water feature or a group of six Happy Buddhas on display.

- To attract prosperity, hang a picture of nine carp fish.
- A three-legged rich toad should be positioned in this area.

Health: Northwest:

- Sleep with your head in this direction. It will be most advantageous if there is a bedroom in this direction.
- The tortoise of Harmony stands for a long life and good health.

Relationships: West:

Put a pair of Mandarin Ducks towards the **direction of the west** to promote romance.

- Peony flowers Image or Love Birds images can be posted if you're looking for love.

Wisdom: Northeast:

- A crystal globe should be positioned in this area.
- Position a picture of the Eight Immortals in this direction.

Inauspicious Directions:**Frustration: South:**

- This location should not be used frequently
- To lessen the negative energy, place a crystal or some semi-precious stones in this direction.

Loss/Theft: North:

Put wooden objects in the **direction of the North**.

Avoid facing it while working, to lessen the effect of the negative energy.

Disease: East:

- The kitchen or a storeroom might benefit from this direction.
- A Temple Lion Protection Plaque should be hung there.

Total Loss: Southeast:

- Do not utilise this space in any way.
- Never purchase a home with the front door facing in this direction.
- Hang a photo of the Phoenix in this direction.
- A toilet, pantry, or kitchen can be built in this direction.

Kua Number 9:**Element: Fire:**

Colors that are harmonious with Kua Number 9 include red, orange, and purple (think “fiery colors”)

Luck-Boosting Woody hues like greens and browns are used as colours.

Auspicious directions for Kua number 9

Success: East:

- The front door of the home should be facing this way.
Use this direction while working or sleeping.
- Point the Money Toad’ or Horse of Successor in this direction.

Health: Southeast:

- Position a water feature in this direction, such as a fountain or an aquarium with 1 blackfish and 8 goldfish.
- Hang a crystal globe.
- Plants with rounded leaves or a money plant should be positioned in this direction.

Relationships: North:

- Position your head to face this way while you sleep.

Place a pair of Mandarin ducks or a Chinese scroll of Mandarin ducks to improve your love life.

Wisdom: South:

- Invest time in this area.
- Hang a picture of the Phoenix to activate the fire element.
- Position a group of elephants or a turtle with a dragon head in this way.

Inauspicious Directions:**Frustration: Northeast**

- When working or sleeping, avoid facing this way.
- Set up a pair of Qi-Lin in this direction to lessen the impact of negative energy.
- Project a scene from nature in this direction.

Loss/Theft: West:

- Do not work facing this direction.

- To prevent dishonest coworkers, direct Kuan Kung or the Four Heavenly Kings in this direction.
- To protect against the negative energy, this space could be converted into a bathroom or a storage space.

Disease: Southwest:

- This space can be converted into a restroom or a storage room.
- Position a pair of Qi Lin in this manner.

Total Loss: Northwest:

- Don't stay here for too long.
- Showcase an aquatic feature.

To decrease the bad energy, hang gemstones in that direction.



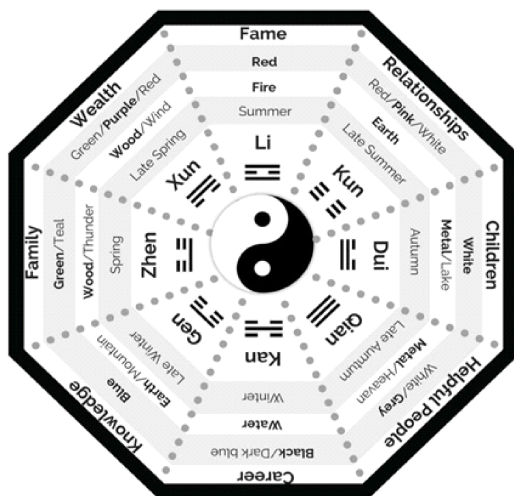
CHAPTER 13

FENGSHUI BAGUA MAP & ITS EFFECTS



“Numerical precision is the very soul of science.”

This is the most important symbol of Feng-shui. The eight sides represents many things and above all it symbolises a powerful protective energy. Chinese people hang this in front of their house, above the main door.

The effect of the missing directions depends on which direction is missing.

The Bagua assigns one type of luck to each of the eight directions of any residence.

When we superimpose the Lo Shu Grid on the Bagua, it is easy to understand the directions. The bagua can also be positioned on any floor plan and the missing directions can be found.

The diagram above illustrates the relationship between the eight-sided Pa-Kua and Lo-Shu magic square's nine grids. Please note that the Pa-Kua shown here places the direction of South at the top, to correspond with the number 9. This is because the Chinese compass places South at the top, and to ensure consistency and accuracy, it is necessary when relationships between symbols are being analyzed, and to comply with the practice followed in the ancient manuals.

Effects of the Missing Zone on Health:

SE MISSING Can be the cause of diseases related to the hips, liver, gallbladder, or thigh	South missing Can be the cause of eye, heart, or digestion issues. Insomnia	SW missing Cause of stomach, spleen, pancreas or muscle joints issues

CHAPTER 14

PERSONAL YEAR GRID

Using the Lo Shu grid, it is also possible to create a certain year’s grid, compare it with the original grid and look for any missing or recurring energy.

How to Build one’s Lo Shu Grid for a given year:

1. Put down your whole date of birth and make the original Lo shu grid for use as a guide and point of comparison.
2. Create your grid based on the following information: Birthday (DD), Birth Month (BM), and Year in Question (2023 if this year is considered, the year in question is always taken from 1st January to 31st December).
3. Take note of the Personal Year Grid’s missing and repeated numbers.

4. Provide solutions to improve a chart's flow while taking the controlling and producing cycle into account.

An illustration would be: Original DOB for a Female: 27/05/1969 BD- 27/9 LP - 3 Kua Number - 11/2

For the shared example:

The person has only the 4 and 8 (Wood and Earth element respectively) missing in the original Lo Shu Grid, rest all elements are present while in the personal year chart of 2023, the numbers are like this:

4, 8, 1, and 6 are missing

8 being an earth element is getting support from 5 and 2. Ample support from 2. So, nothing to be done.

4 is getting support from 3, another wood element.

6 is also getting support from 7, another metal zone.

A person can improve 1 by being asked to wear blue-colored clothing, energise water in the North Zone in a blue bottle, and conserve water rather than waste it in any way.

Conclusion:

In this way, for a specific year, we may aid people and offer them cures to make it easier for them to handle their problems.



CHAPTER 15

REMEDIES

Missing Earth Element:

- Place your office or bedroom towards the southwest.
- Employ a square or rectangular hardwood dining table.

Maintain a greenstone pyramid in the southwest for steadiness and strength.

- Attach a mountain photo on the south sidewall of your home.
- Place a yellow light bulb in the room’s middle.

Put natural crystals in the northeast and southwest.

- Granite glass pebbles

Any sort of red, orange, and yellow fruit is great for soil because fire creates it.

Missing Metal Element:

- Accessorize your right hand with gold.
- Place a wind chime in the west, northwest, or north. It should be golden yellow.
- Keep bronze, silver, or gold metal statues in the west or northwest.

Colors of metallic colours, such as whites and golds, look fantastic here when paired with earth tones.

Wind chimes are terrific here since they bring down bad luck and also bring good luck.

Missing Water Element:

- Maintain a basin of water towards east or northeast.
- Offer water to thirsty people. You can also keep a fish aquarium with water.
- A fountain or swimming pool will also be useful in the north.
- Water should never flow outward from a home, only inward.
- Even though your bedroom is in the north, a water feature is not appropriate there.
- The north-facing area of another room can always be powered up.

Maintain a red lamp in the southeast corner of your room.

Missing Fire Element:

- Place a flowering plant in your living room.
- Position the oven so it faces southeast.

Maintain an energetic red pyramid. Green and red make a fantastic colour combination.

Missing Wood Element:

- Place musical doorbell chimes at the front door.
- Maintain order and cleanliness in your home's northeast side.
- Install a green light facing east and south.
- On the east, southeast, and northeast, hang a picture of some greenery;
- Surround yourself with plants and wooden items.

Remedies in details for missing numbers in the Lo Shu grid:

The table below can help you to fix the missing numbers in your Lo Shu grid
