

This was the **starting** point of my spiritual **journey** as well. I wanted answers for which I **embarked** on a **soul-searching** mission, visiting **ashrams** in Rishikesh, attending countless **spiritual retreats**, and doing whatever I could to **unravel this truth**. The **turning point** came in a simple **yogic session**, where my teacher began by saying, "Your first purpose is to serve yourself by taking care of yourself: physically, mentally, emotionally, and spiritually".

That statement struck a **chord** deep within me. It summed up everything I had been searching for. How true this was! My first purpose was **to take care of myself**. If I am **healthy** and **whole** in every aspect of my life, I am able to serve the people around me; **my family, my clients**, and those in need. As **spiritual women**, we are often driven to **serve others**, sometimes even at the cost of **harming ourselves**. We give, give, and give, **forgetting to nurture** ourselves first. But this lesson served as an **eye-opening reminder** that we must **service ourselves first**, before we can effectively serve others.

Imagine you are a **candle**. Your light is meant to **illuminate** the world around you, but it can only shine brightly if you're **well-lit** yourself. If your wick is short, your flame will be weak. If

your wax is melting too quickly, your light will flicker and go out.

Imagine a singer whose melodious voice **stirs emotions** in the hearts of others, through his **singing**, he

While your larger **mission-to serve**, **love and create impact**-will remain

consistent, the paths you choose to **express** that purpose will shift as you **evolve spiritually and emotionally**.

This is why being aligned is an inside job. It's not about following rigid rules or fixed goals but about staying connected to your inner wisdom and adapting with grace as life unfolds. The more your nurture this alignment, the more effortless it becomes to merge your purpose with profits.

Connecting Purpose to Profits

Once you are **aligned with your purpose**, your work becomes more than just a business, it becomes a **spiritual calling**. I realised that by helping other women **discover their own power**.

I could guide them toward a more enriched life. Witnessing their growth and happiness was incredibly fulfilling, and making profits through this work felt completely natural. Profiting from my purpose wasn't just enjoyable-it was essential. It provided me with the resources to expand my impact, help more women, and support my family without depleting myself.

When you can connect your unique purpose to profit, you create a win-win situation: You are serving others in a meaningful way, and at the same time, you are generating abundance in your own life. A continuous, healthy flow of wealth, like a well-oiled system, creates this harmonious arrangement. This set up enables you to reinvest in your spiritual business and expand your reach, and eventually support even more women.

When we talk about **financial success**, nearly every book on **financial literacy** emphasises the importance of having **long-term** and **short-term** goals. These **goals** are typically broken down into **time-stamped milestones**, followed by **systematic plans** for achieving them by **calendar**. This too, is **tightly structured**. But, as a **spiritual coach** or entrepreneur, you know **first-hand** how the **coaching industry** really **works**. There are days when you have clients lining up to work with you, and then there are days when it feels like you're **stranded in the desert**, wondering where everyone went. The flow of clients can **feel unpredictable**, making the idea of **streamlining your spiritual business** seem like a distant **dream**.

But what if it doesn't have to be? What if you could create a vision and a roadmap for your spiritual business that allows for the natural ebbs and flows as a feminine entrepreneur, while keeping you on track toward financial abundance?

In this chapter, we will talk about the importance of goal setting, the skills needed to excel financially, and the **spiritual rules** that will help you **manifest** your **millionaire vision**. But before we dive into the details of **creating** that **roadmap**, I want to ask a very important question; one that will make all the **difference** in your journey:

Do You Feel Worthy of Earning a Million?

This may be one of the most sensitive yet essential topics when it comes to wealth building. Many people set financial goals, dreams of earning millions; but rarely do they stop and ask themselves, "Do I feel worthy enough to earn and own that million?" Do you?

It was within me; within my own energetic system. Working through with wealth code matrix, opened up floodgates of opportunities, clients and ideas that helped me propel forward with more alignment and clarity.

Reprogramming Your Mind for Wealth

The lack I felt in my life wasn't because there were **no clients**, **opportunities**, **or money** in the world. It was because I had not yet **rewired** my mind to feel worthy of **financial success**. By improving areas like digital payments, data analysis and automation, I could streamline operations and expand my reach effectively. Once I identified these areas, I could work on them purposefully, rather than feeling overwhelmed by all the things I thought I had to do.

Setting Goals That Align with Your Purpose

The next important step in crafting your millionaire roadmap is to set goals that resonate with your soul purpose, not just financial figures. Once I released the pressure to be perfect, my goals began to attune more deeply with my inner calling rather than simply chasing financial success. I promised myself to achieve success on my own timeline, without rushing or stressing over arbitrary deadlines.

It's easy to **feel discouraged** when you see people around you or even your close friends, climbing the ladder of success faster than you. You start to question, "What's wrong with me?

Why am I not **generating** the same results?" But the truth is, **everyone's journey is different.** When you create a **vision** that focuses on how you can **benefit your clients** and give yourself **permission** to achieve success in your **own time**, you feel more at ease. You **allow flexibility and adaptability** to shape **your business**.

The Rule of 3: A Simple Framework for Goal Achievement

This method, based on the Rule of 3, helps create a clear roadmap for achieving your business goals in a structured yet flexible way.

1. 3 Key Focus Areas

Identify 3 core areas of your business that need attention. These should be the most impactful areas that will provide growth.

2. Break It Into 3 Quarters

Divide your work into 3 quarters, each lasting around 3 weeks. Focus on advancing the key areas within each quarter.

3. 3 Weeks per Quarter

Each quarter consists of only 3 weeks to work. In these weeks, break your larger goals into focused tasks that contribute directly to progress. Take a regular break every 4th week.

4. 3 Days per Week

Dedicate only 3 days a week to focused work on the tasks that align with your goals. Consistency over time is key.

5. Daily 3 Sub-Tasks

Each day, break your larger tasks into 3 smaller sub-tasks. This ensures steady progress and prevents overwhelming feelings.

This method helps you:

Focus on **smaller**, **actionable steps** while still keeping the bigger picture in mind.

Stay on track with a clear timeline that keeps you **moving** forward without the stress of strict deadlines.

Create a roadmap for achieving your goals with **clarity** and **consistency**.

While I personally prefer to **go with the flow**, you may find this method helpful, if you thrive in a more **systemised and structured** environment.

When you set goals, make sure they are aligned with your soul mission and not just focused on monetary gain. It's not just about earning a million; it's about establishing a business that is purpose-driven, sustainable, and brings you fulfilment.

By doing this **growth work** and creating a roadmap that is aligned with your purpose and vision of wealth, you'll not only achieve financial success but also experience a **lasting sense of accomplishment.**

These qualities are our **superpowers**, but in a world that frequently **undervalues emotional and spiritual intelligence**, it is easy to struggle with how to **convert** these **gifts** into **high-value services**.

When I first started my journey as a **spiritual coach**, I was filled with **doubts** about my offerings. My services were a **mix of different** approaches, trying to solve **everyone's** problems all at once. I offered **tarot readings**, **spiritual coaching**, and a variety of **healing modalities**. I was trying to be everything to everyone, but this only led to **burnout** and mixed results for my clients.

During those days, I often offered my premium services for free or at very low rates because I believed that as a spiritual healer, I was here to help others, not to make money. I thought charging higher rate was wrong or unspiritual. But soon I realised I was not only undervaluing myself and my work, but I was also doing a disservice to my clients. When we undervalue ourselves, we communicate that our services are not worthy of investment, which undermines the power of transformation that we are capable of offering.

Through introspection and self-evaluation, I stepped into my power as a spiritual coach. With this deeper understanding, I began to redesign my offerings, to craft services that resonated with my higher purpose and delivered exceptional

value to my clients. This newfound clarity gave me the confidence to charge what my services truly deserved.

The Tarot Journey: A Lesson in Service Design

At the start of my services offering journey, **tarot** reading served as my **primary tool**. I have a **deep connection to tarot**; it is my first love and an **integral part** of my **spiritual practice**.

When I researched, I discovered the market was flooded with **Tarot readers**, many offering **quick predictions** for clients seeking **instant solutions** to life's deeper issues. But this was not the true purpose of **Tarot**. To me, **tarot** is **sacred**. It's not just a tool for predicting the future; it is a **gateway** to connect with **divine consciousness**, explore the depths of our **subconscious**, and **access** the **higher wisdom** within our **human psyche**.

However, I soon realised that many of my clients **mistook** me for those **quick-fix**, **predictive Tarot card readers**, expecting me to provide **instant solutions** to their problems. They sought answers to their **current challenges** but were not interested in **addressing the root causes**. After receiving a reading, they would leave without doing any of the **inner work** required for **true transformation**. They believed that simple solutions, like **gemstones**, **crystals**, **or spiritual spells**, would bring them the results they desired. But this approach did not **resonate** with me. My soul longed for deeper, more **meaningful transformation**; both for myself and for my clients.

I wanted them to understand that **true healing** demands **commitment**. You can't solve life's challenges simply by wearing **gemstones or performing rituals**. While these tools

can be **valuable**, they only complement the work you have **already done within yourself**. It is like trying to maintain **good health** by **relying solely** on **vitamins** but **ignoring** the need for regular exercise and a balanced diet. Vitamins are helpful, but they cannot **replace the foundation** of **good habits**.

It is important to understand, spiritual healing is an on-going process that requires time, dedication, and self-responsibility.

It was clear to me that my current offerings did not align with my soul purpose. So, I made the decision to redesign my services to reflect the deep healing and lasting change, I wanted to offer. Instead of promoting tarot readings as standalone services, I began incorporating them into my coaching packages. Tarot became a tool to open up meaningful conversations with my clients, to help them access their own inner wisdom, but the intensive work began with the coaching and healing that followed.

Designing Intuitive High-Value Services

The key to **creating high-value spiritual services** is to ensure that your offerings are guided by your **soul**, not by what is expected of you or by what **the market demands**. When I shifted my focus from pleasing everyone to **serving in alignment** with my **soul's calling**, my clients began experiencing lasting **transformation**, and I found greater **fulfilment** in my work.

I also made a **critical shift** in my approach: I stopped focusing on the **modalities** I was using (tarot, energy healing, bach etc.) and started focusing on the **results** I was delivering. Before,

clients were **confused** by the long list of modalities I offered: **tarot**, **energy healing**, **numerology**, **NLP** and more. They didn't know which one to choose for their **specific problems**. But once I shifted to **focusing** on the **outcomes they desired**, my services became **clearer** to them.

This **insight** allowed me to raise the **value of my offerings**. Clients didn't need to fully understand the modalities **I employed**; they simply needed to know that I could **deliver the results** they were seeking. **By trusting** my **intuition** and **choosing** the **right tools** for each client, I was able to **guide** them through their own **shifts** with **greater confidence**.

The Power of Intuitive Service Design

As I began to tune into my higher self through meditation and soul practices, I started to receive clear answers about how to develop new offerings. I realised that serving from the soul gave me an edge over others in the crowded coaching market. My soul-guided services felt pure and allowed me to connect with my clients at a significant level.

By integrating my intuitive abilities, I could design services that resonated not just with me, but with the clients I was meant to serve. And as I shifted the focus from modalities to outcomes, I began attracting clients who were ready to commit to their transformation, rather than those looking for short term remedy. It was a win-win for both of us.

Service with soul means aligning your offerings with your unique gifts and allowing them to evolve as you grow spiritually. When you design your services from a place of genuineness and focus on the results your clients will

experience, you'll not only feel more **satisfied** but will also see **your business multiply**.

By designing your services with soul and focusing on the **deeper transformations** you can offer, you will attract clients who are ready for the healing and growth you are here to provide. This is where true **spiritual service and financial success meet.**


