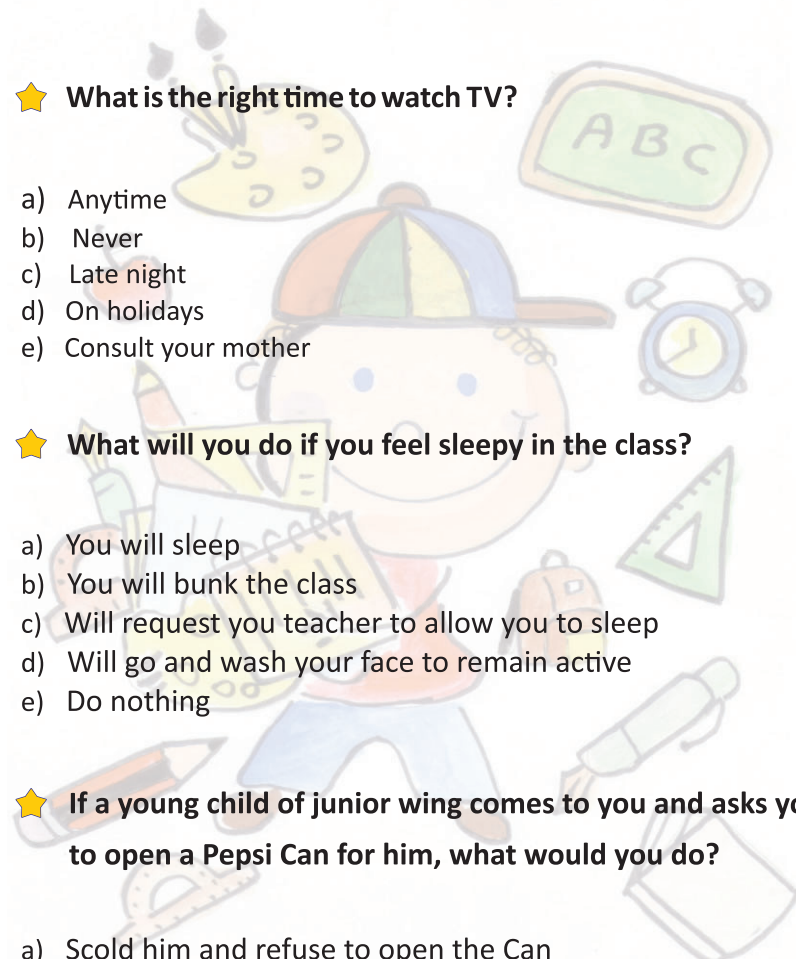
"This *Story* tells you that . . .
