I invite you to this fun ride of emotions, friendships, magic and discovery.

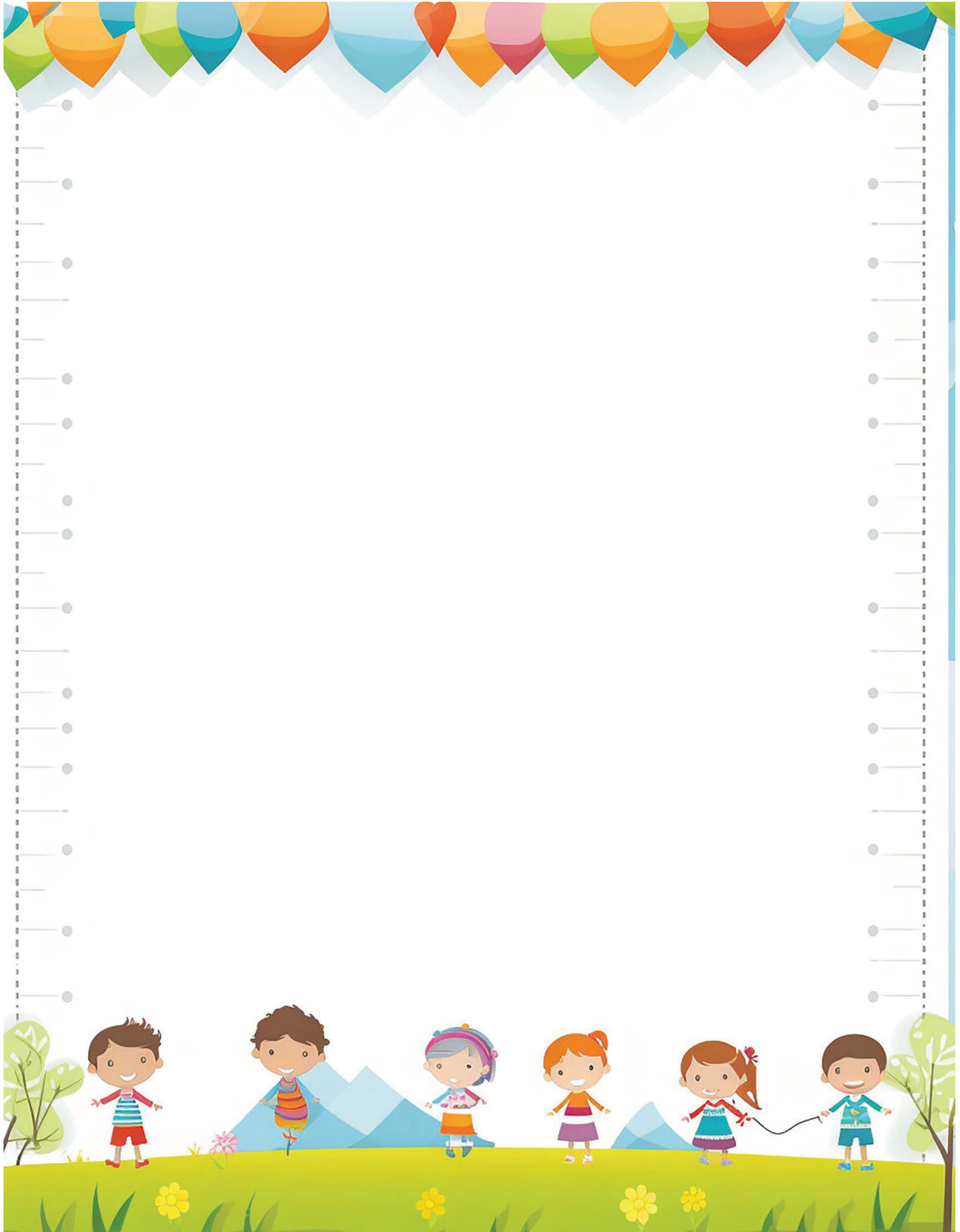

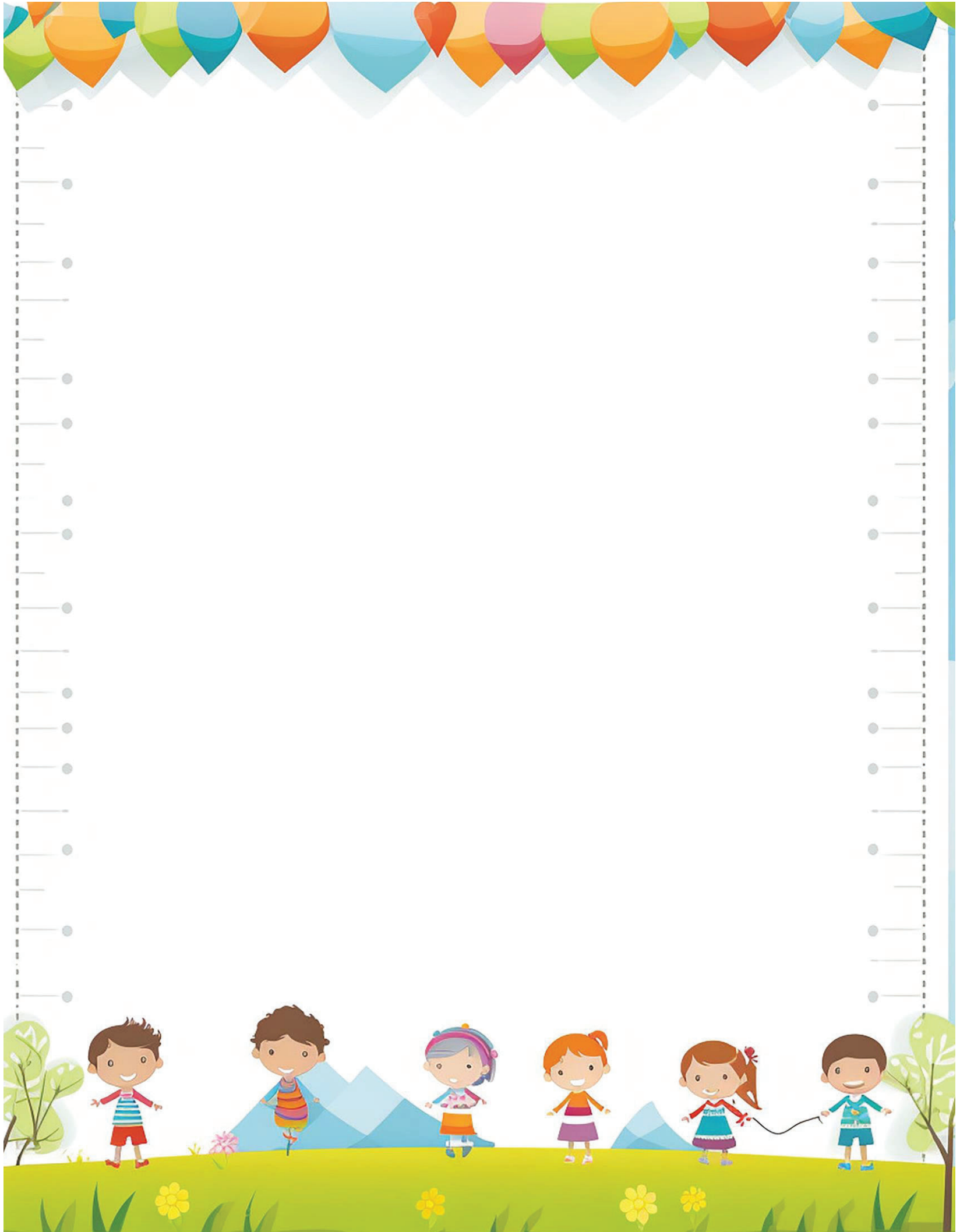


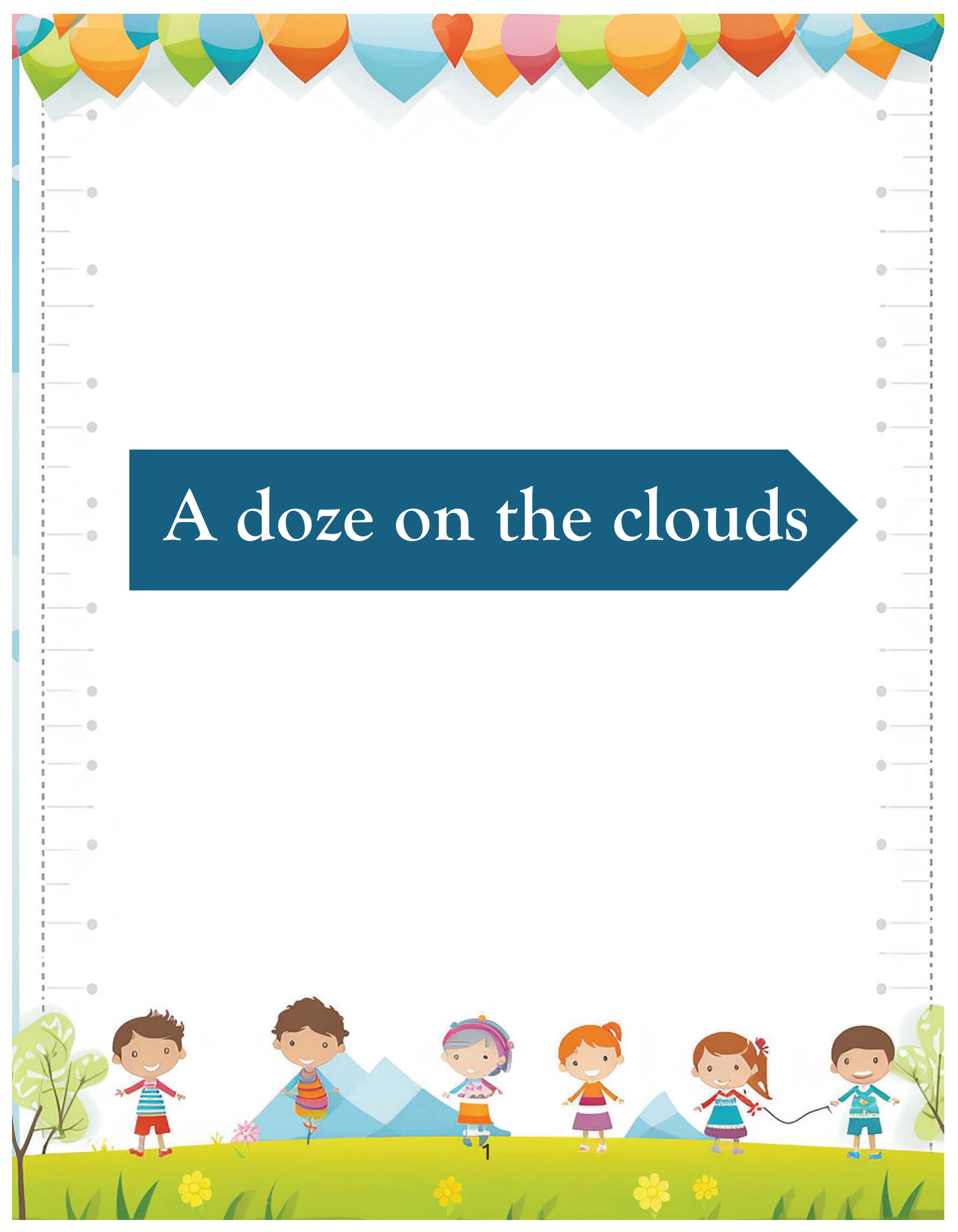


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A doze on the clouds

were jumping on a trampoline**



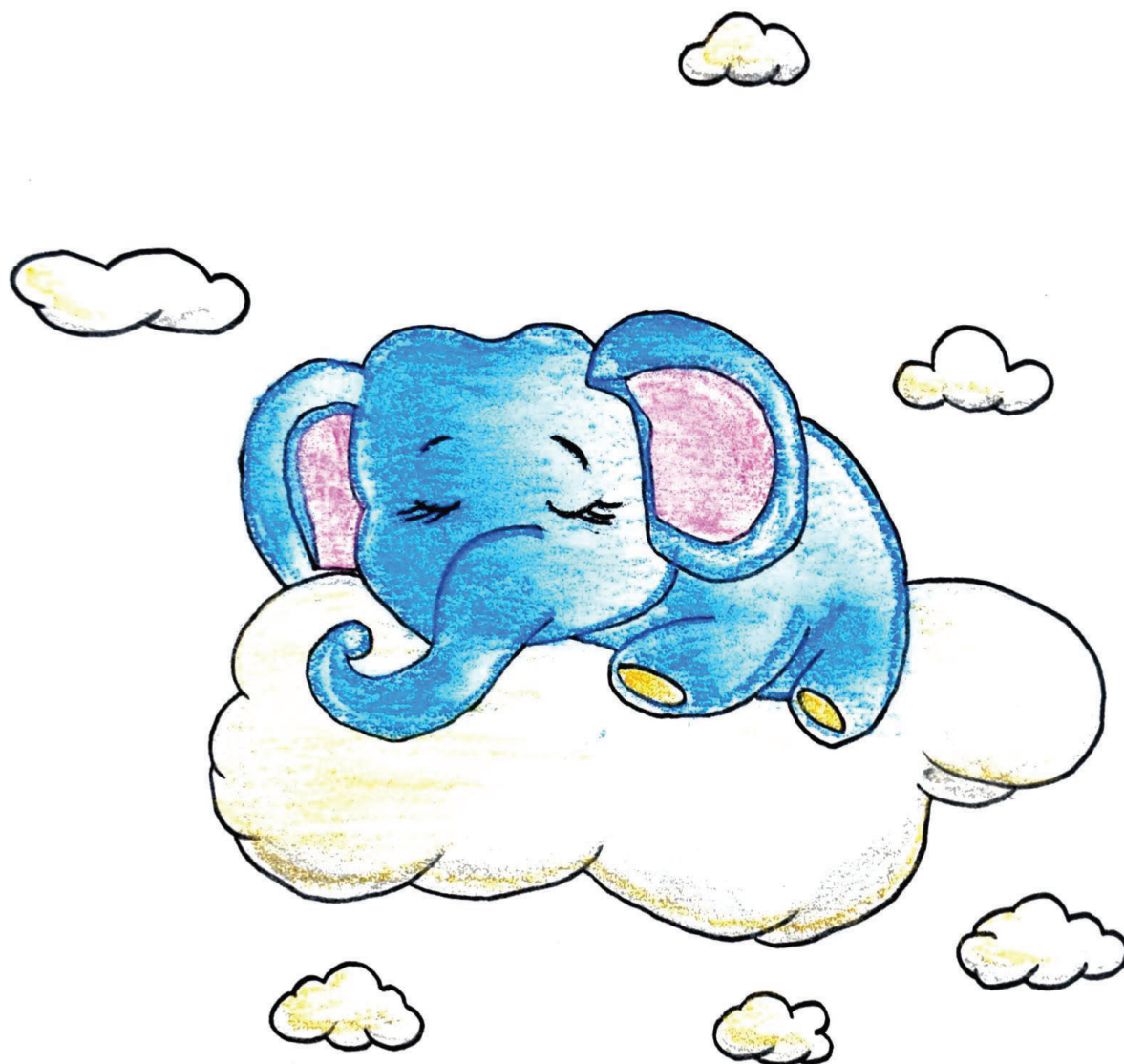
**The elephant jumped and
jumped high into the sky**



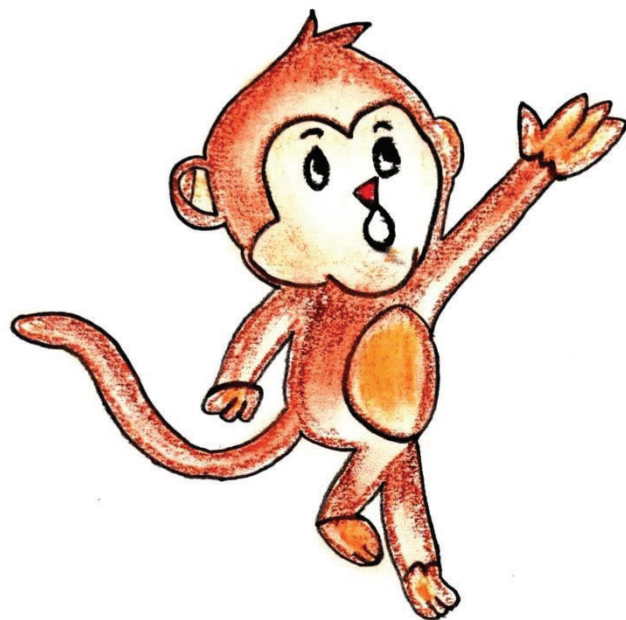
**The elephant then
landed on a cloud**



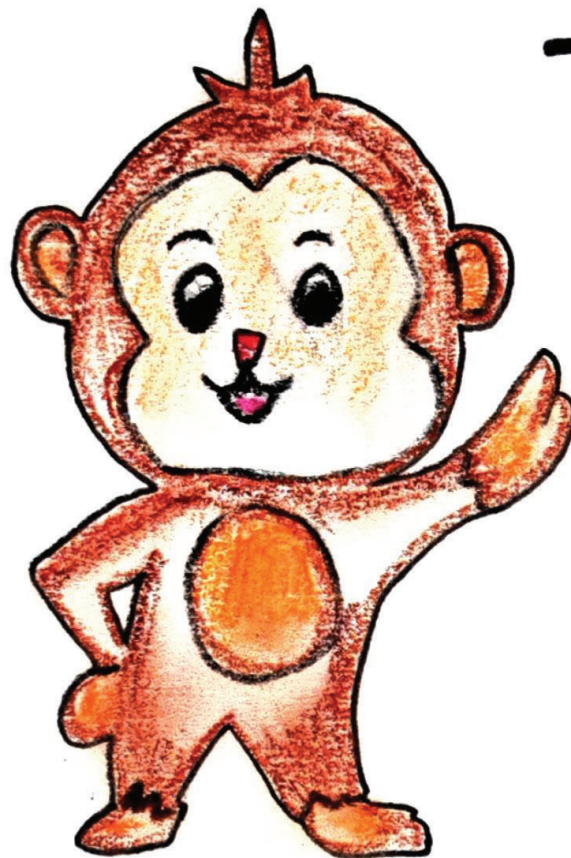
And fell asleep

The elephant woke up and helped the monkey come up

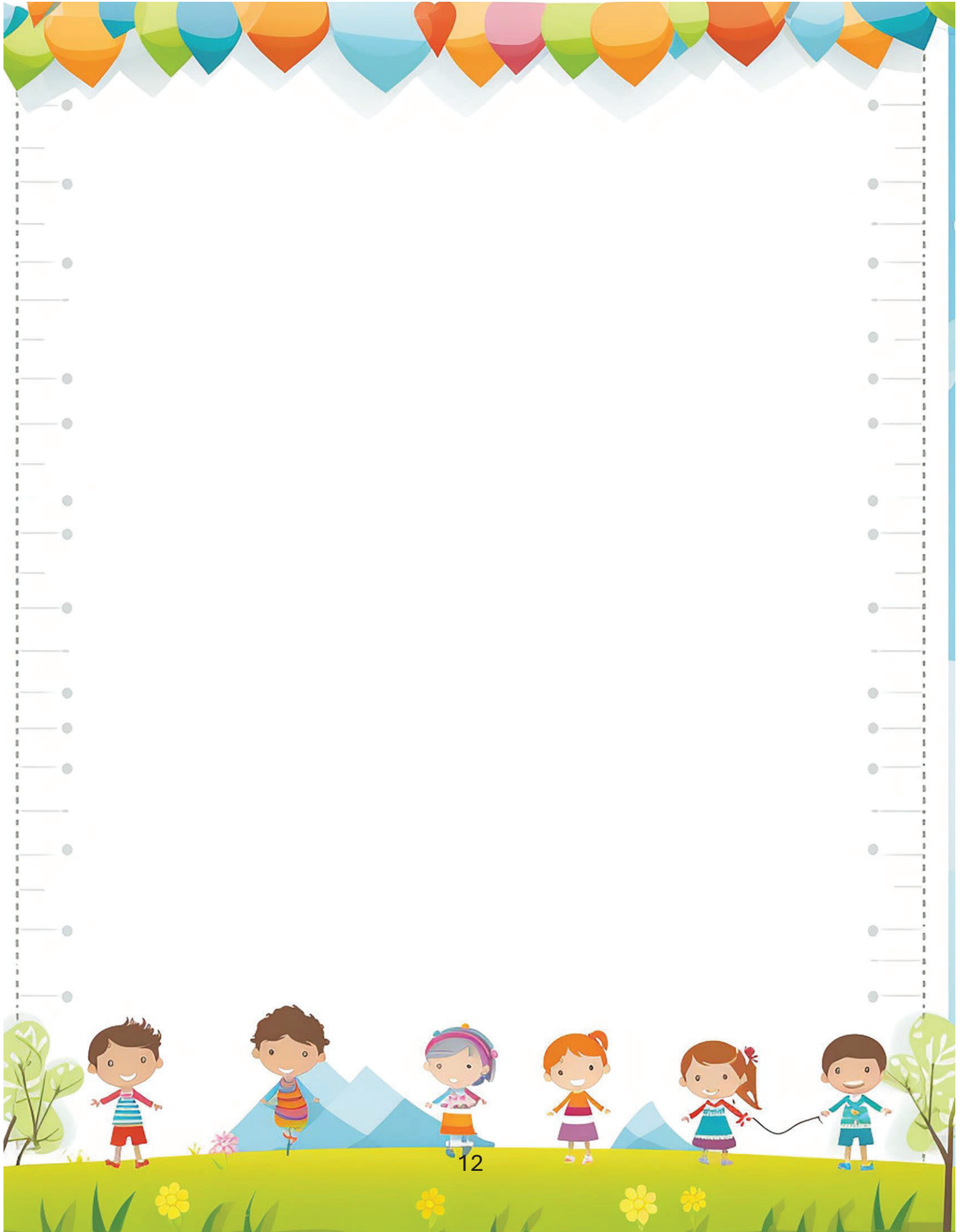


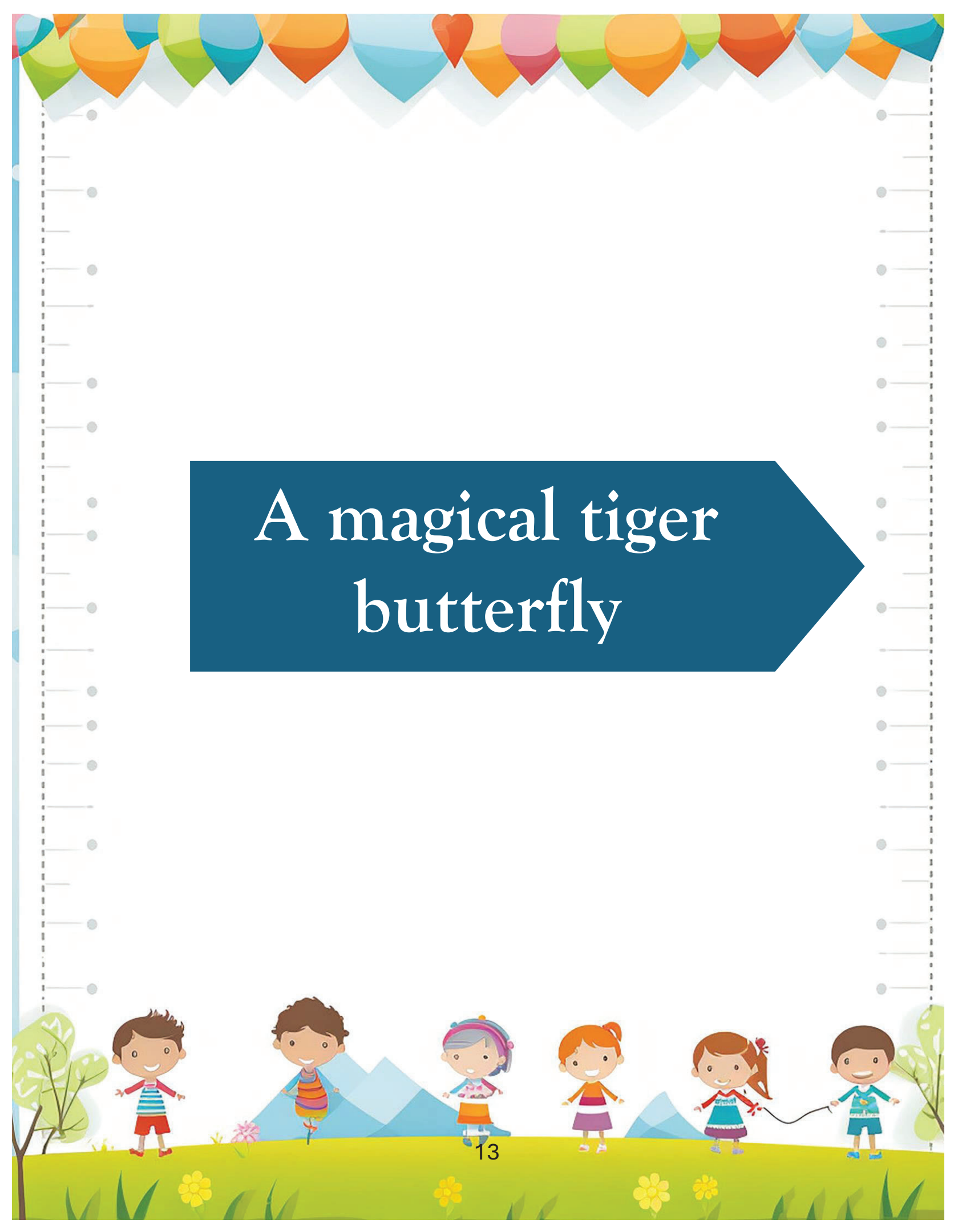
The monkey climbed onto the cloud

Beautiful giant butterfly

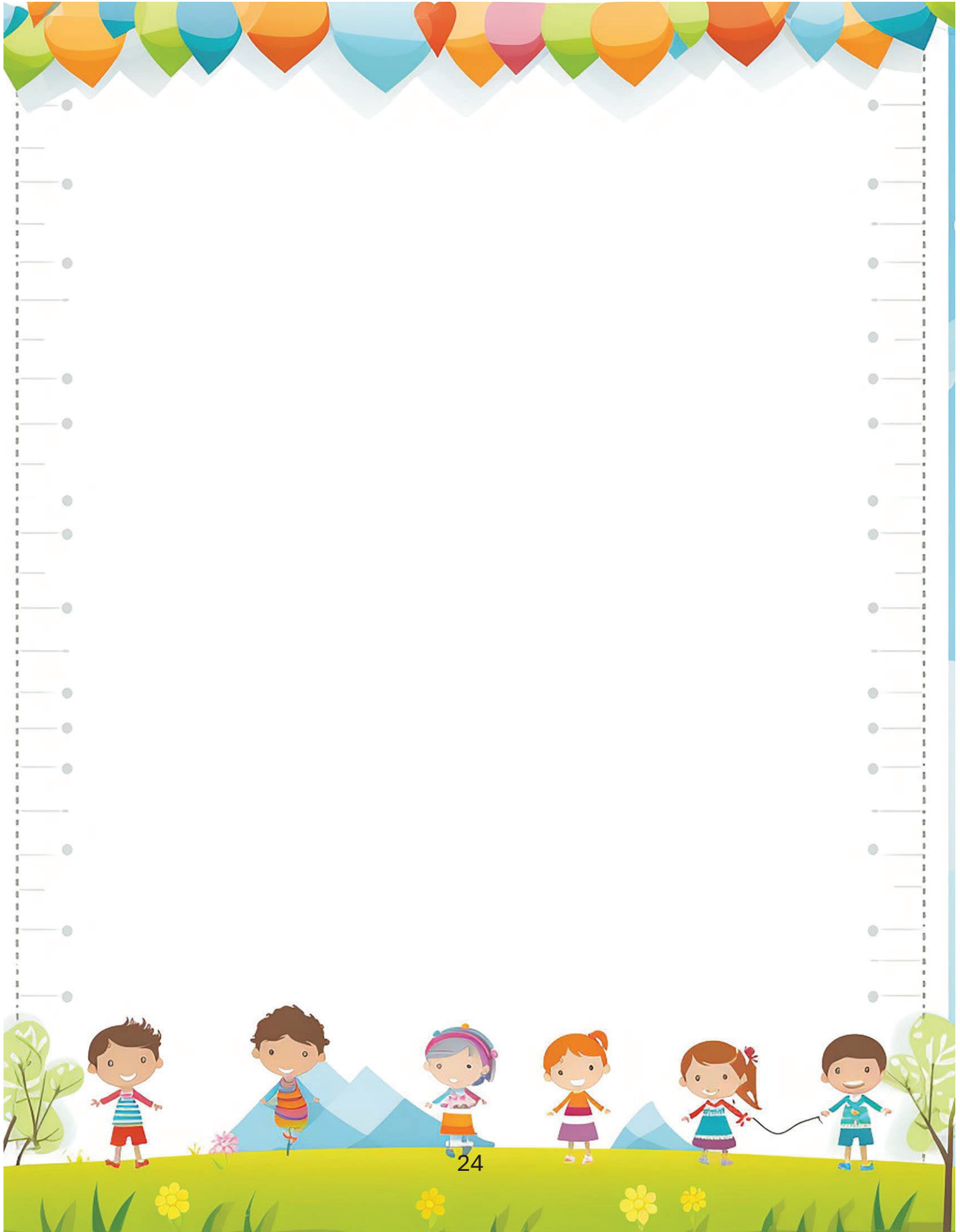

That is now called 'Tiger Butterfly'



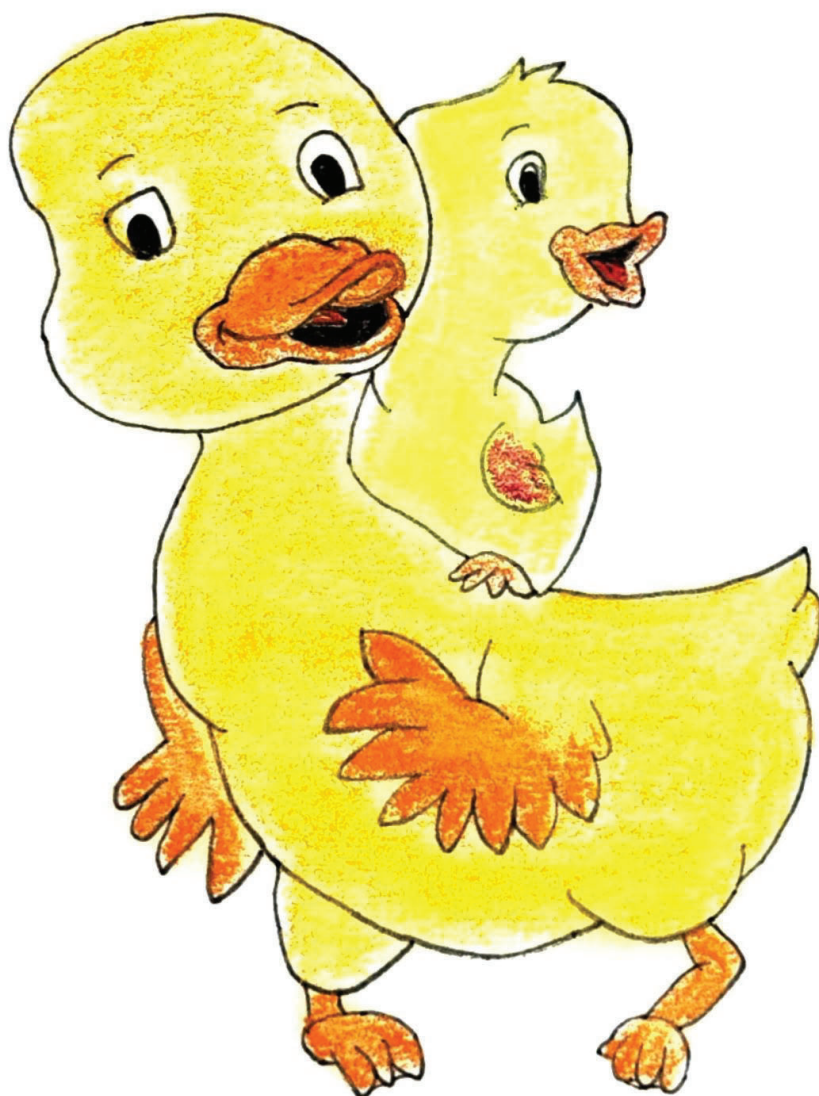




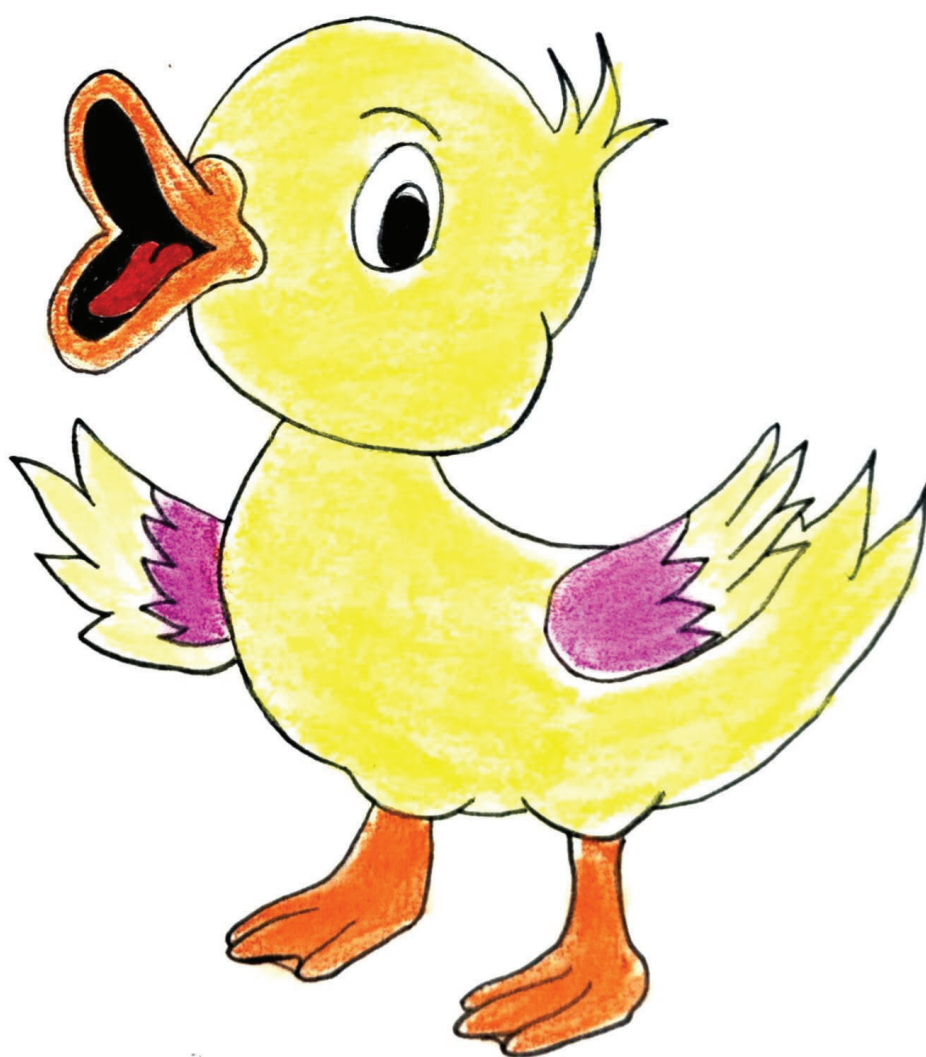

“ Moo! Moo!”**



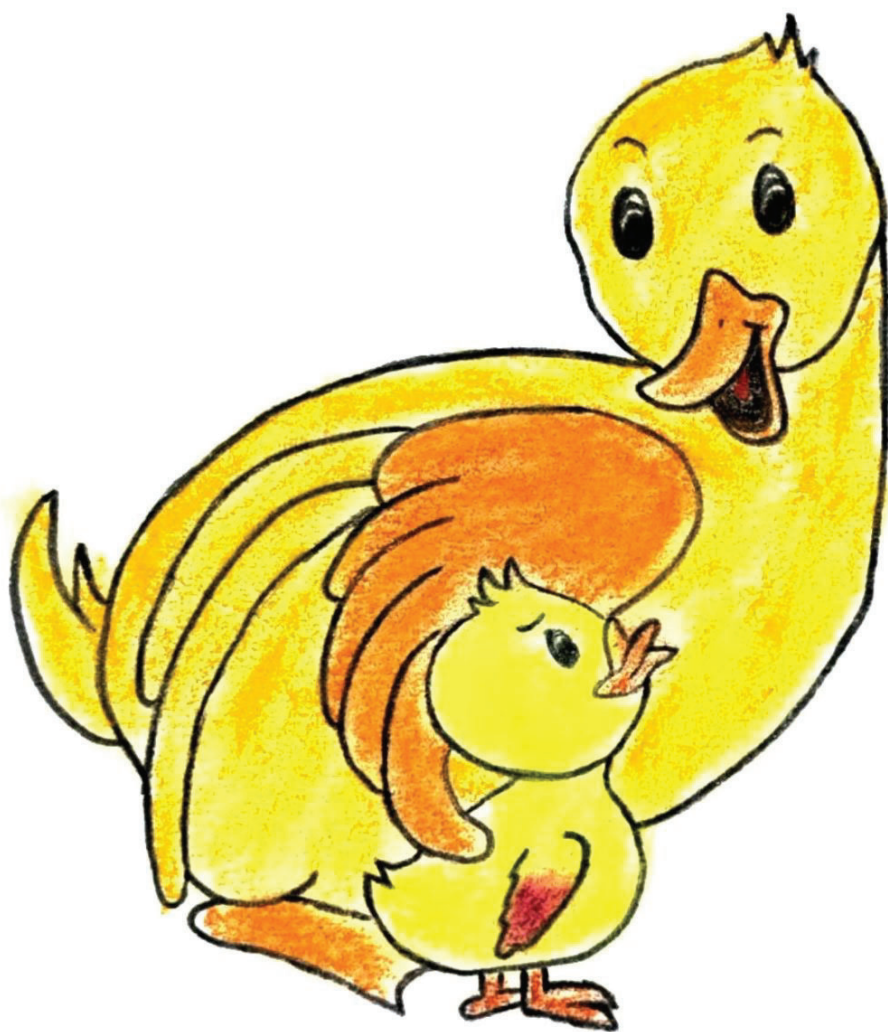

NUMBER ENDING WITH 00 WITH 25

- 1) FIRST START WITH AN EXAMPLE: $100 \div 25$
- 2) NOW CROSS 00 IN THE GIVEN NUMBER : $1\cancel{0}\cancel{0}$
- 3) REMAINING NUMBER IS 1
- 4) NOW MULTIPLY IT WITH 4 : $1 \times 4 = 4$
- 5) ANSWER : $100 \div 25 = 4$

- 2) $500 \div 25 =$
- 3) $900 \div 25 =$

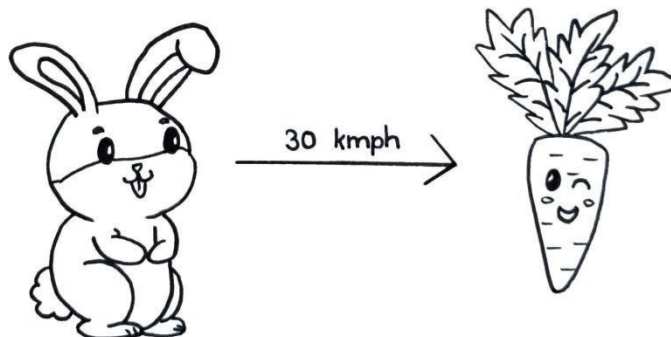
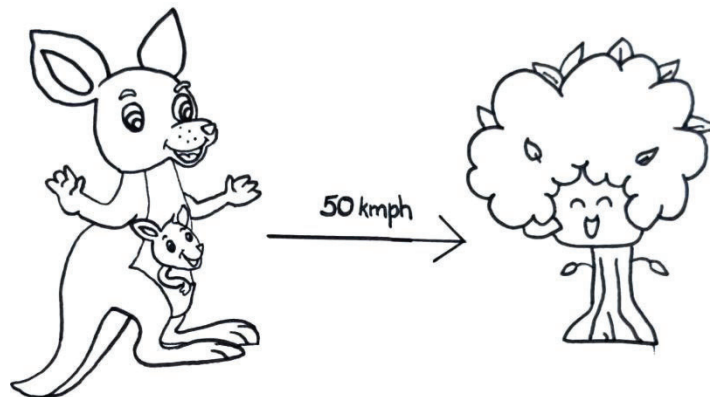
