“He’s too small.”

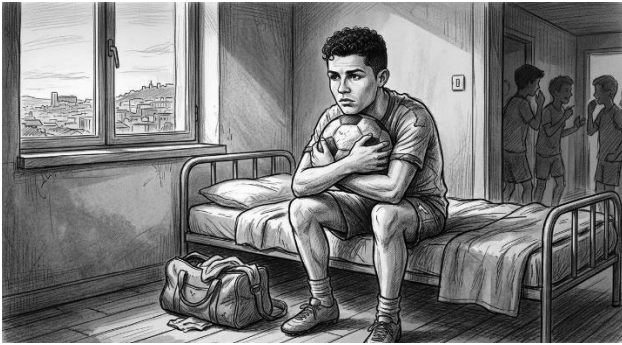
“He’s too skinny.”

But he wasn't staying in Portugal for long.

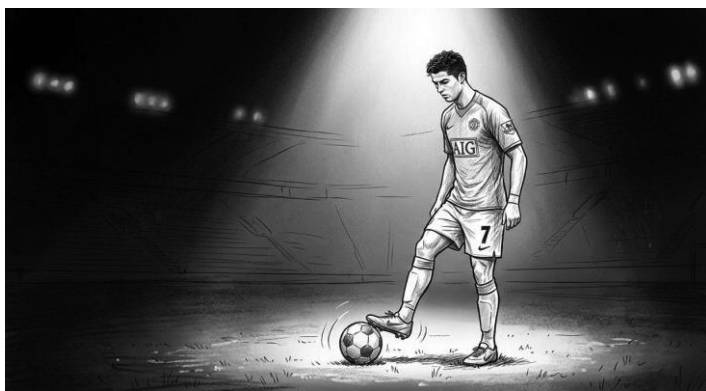

It was mutual elevation.

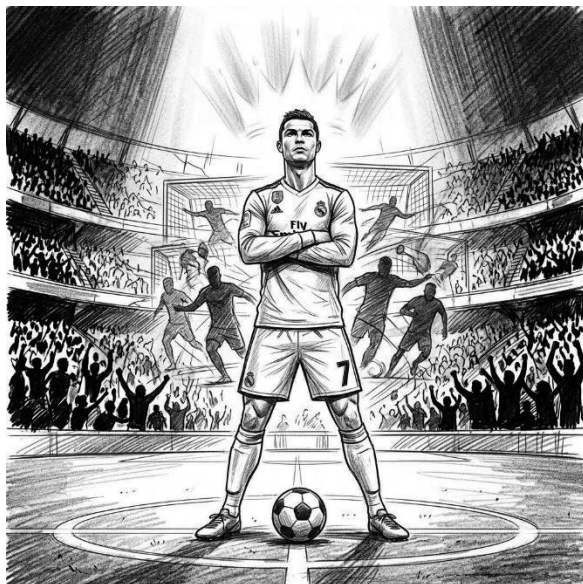

He scored from everywhere: headers, volleys, free-kicks, screamers from 30 yards.

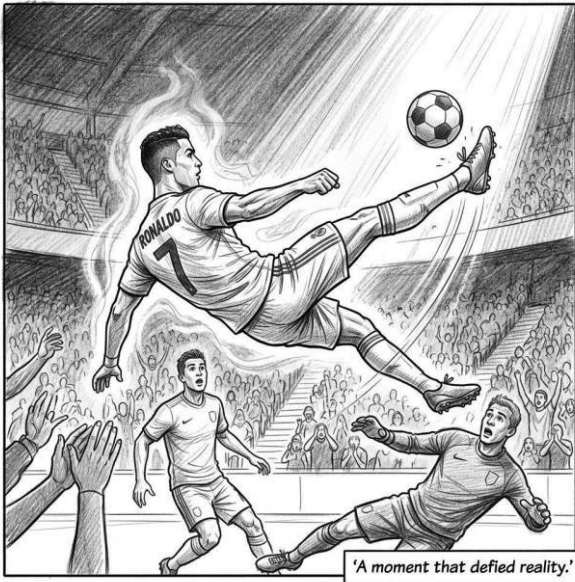
Teammates: "He trained like it was life or death."

He entered **football mythology**.

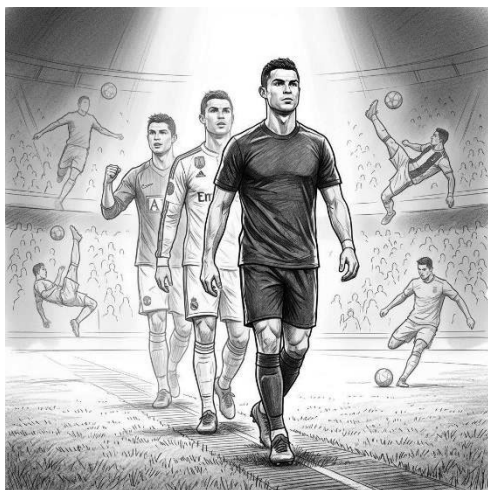
Chapter 15:

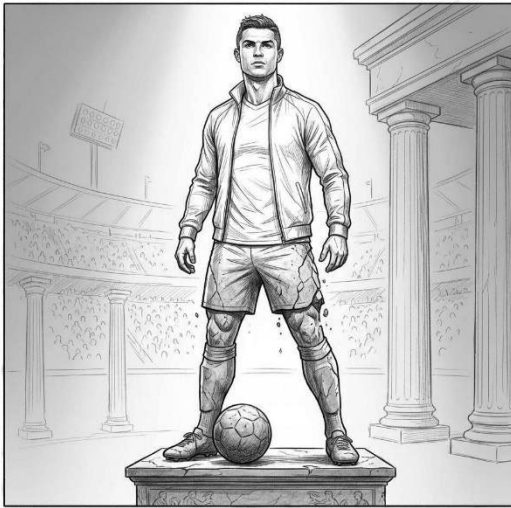

Contract terminated.

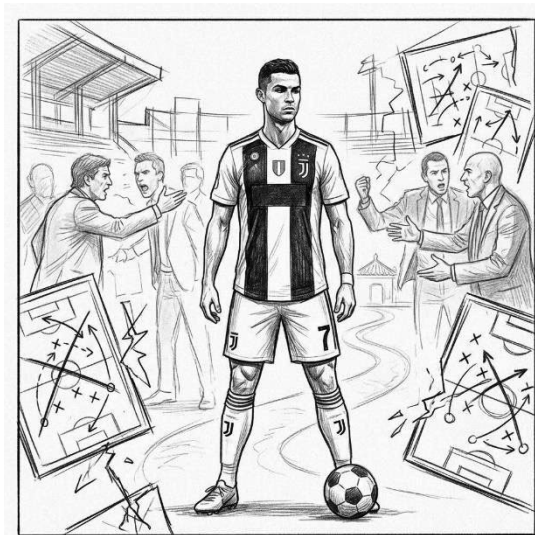

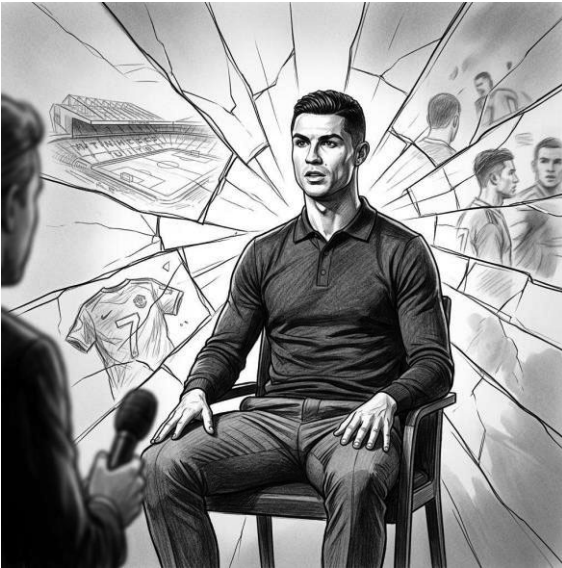

Their relationship became a Netflix docuseries. Glamorous. Public. Emotional.

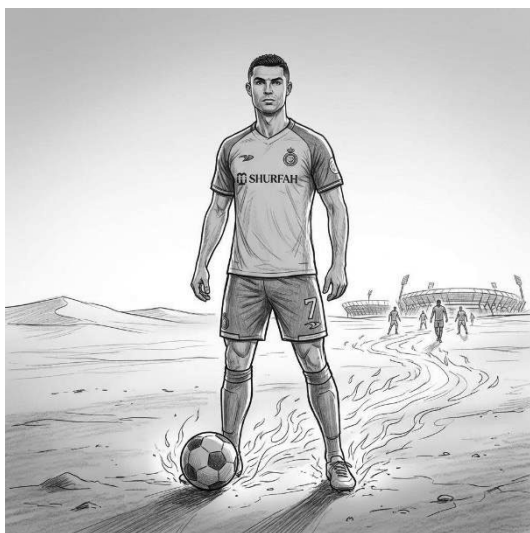
But it hasn't all been beautiful. In 2022, Georgina gave birth to twins — but only one survived.

Cristiano Ronaldo – Important Match Highlights

1. Sporting CP vs Manchester United (2003) – The Breakout Game

- **Date:** August 6, 2003
 - **What happened:** In a pre-season friendly, 18-year-old Ronaldo absolutely *destroyed* United's defense. So much so, the United players begged Sir Alex Ferguson to sign him immediately.
